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
### WORKSHOPS

  - Beginner LaTeX


### RESULTS

Since February 2019, we have conducted 45 total workshops with 394 registrants and 41 walk-ins.


#### Classification



#### How did you hear about this workshop?




#### How do you rate your skills after learning about this workshop topic?
