The Minutes of meeting of Sept 6th were read and approved after Regent J L Wilkin had been elected President Protem.

Upon recommendation of President Boyd Dr C S Bobo was appointed as Lecturer in Forensic Medicine at a salary of 50.00 per semester and Assistant Teachers were designated as follows

Upon motion duly seconded and carried Prest Boyd was authorized to purchase a piano from Mrs. J E Davis at a cost not exceeding 175.00 for use in the Women's Gymnasium.

President Boyd was also authorized to invite leading citizens of the Territory to deliver lectures before the student bodies, when arrangements could be made for same at a cost not exceeding railroad fare and necessary expenses incurred in making the visit to the University for that purpose.

The President was also directed to at once prepare and cause to be issued catalogue for year 1906 and have same ready for distribution by close of present school year.

The Regents being advised that the University Orchestra under charge of Prof H D Guelick had been assigned a prominent place on the Program of the Territorial Teachers Association at Enid during the holiday week and it appearing that the orchestra was not financially able to meet the expenses of said trip, the Regents directed that the actual and necessary expenses incurred on said trip would be paid upon presentation of a duly verified itemized statement of said expenses.

The committee consisting of Regents Wood and Larsh appointed to audit the accounts of Mr. Roy Hadsell Registrar from date of last audit July 28-1903, filed their report of audit of said accts up to Sept 1-1905, showing said accts

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to be correct and that there was a balance on hand with Registrar on said date of 2315.11. The report of the committee was approved and their recommendation that the sum of 88.14 and \$1982.90 be transferred from "Diploma Fund" and "Chemical Laboratory Fund" respectively, and placed to credit of funds as follows towit Piano Fund, \$324.49 Voice Fund 516.70 and Violin Fund 229.85, were ordered carried into effect. Their recommendation that the Registrar of the University be required to give Bond in the sum of Five thousand dollars in some surety company authorized to do business in the Territory, was approved by the Regents, and it was further directed that the premium on said Bond be borne by the University.

Upon recommendation of President Boyd, Prof J E Sturgis was promoted to rank of Professor of Latin at a salary of 1200.00 per annum for years 1905-1906, and Prof John F Paxton appointed Professor of Greek and Roman Archology. (sic)

The action of President Boyd in purchasing pictures and engravings for the University at a cost of 85. was approved.
