Friday Morning, April 14th, 1911.

The State Board of Education met in their rooms on Friday morning, April 14th, at ten o'clock. The meeting was called to order by the president, R. H. Wilson. All members were present.

Mr. D. Frank Redd, President of the Northeastern State Normal School at Tahlequah, appeared before the Board and was questioned concerning conditions in that institution.

Mr. E. B. Nelson, Superintendent of the Boys' Training School at Pauls Valley, appeared before the Board and made a statement concerning the Boys' School.

Mr. Grant B. Grumbine, President of the Northwestern State Normal School of Alva, appeared before the Board and reported upon the School at Alva.

The President made the following announcement of Committees on Visitation for the different institutions.


First Committee: Weatherford, Enid, Chickasha, Alva, and Langston---


Third Committee: Pauls Valley, Sulphur, Ada, Durant, and Wilburton --
