Saturday Morning, June 10th, 1911.

The Board was called to order at 10:00 o'clock Saturday morning, June 10th, 1911, by the President. All members were present.

President J. Alex Morre of Chickasha appeared before the Board.

On motion by Mr. Scott, seconded by Mr. Dunlop, his hearing was postponed pending a conference with the Committee on the Course of Study.

All voted aye.

Three voted aye, two voted no. Mr. Dunlop voted no.

President Briles made a request that the members of his faculty who failed to be recommended for re-election be given a leave of absence on pay for the month of June.


All voted aye.
