
The following report of the Salary Committee on salaries for the Institution for the Feeble Minded was read and adopted:

SATURDAY MORNING, JUNE 17th, 1911.

The Board was called to order by the President at 3:00 o'clock Saturday afternoon, June 17th, 1911. All members were present except Mr. Brandenburg.

On motion by Mr. Glen, seconded by Mr. Scott, the salary of the Dean to be employed for the Medical School at the University was fixed at \$3000.00.

All voted aye.

On motion by Mr. Scott, seconded by Mr. Dunlop, the report of the Committee on salary was approved with the exception that the salaries of the First Assistants in English, History, Mathematics and Foreign Languages in Normal Schools be made \$1100.00 instead of \$1000.00. The report is as follows:

The salaries of the Presidents of the Normal Schools \$2500.00 with \$200.00 travelling expenses. The heads of departments \$1400.00. Assistants range from \$900.00 for new employees to \$1100.00 given the First Assistants as stated above.

On motion by Mr. Glen, seconded by Mr. Scott, the salary of the Second Assistants in the Department of English at the University, Miss Brooks and Miss Loomis, were fixed at \$1100.00. All voted aye.

On motion by Mr. Scott, seconded by Mr. Glen, Mr. Dunlop was given authority to represent the Board of Education in arranging with the Board of Affairs for such improvements as they deem necessary in the State Normal School at Edmond. All voted aye.

On motion the Board adjourned to meet on Wednesday, June 21st, 1911.
