Special meeting of Regents pursuant to adjournment of June 2nd '96.

Mr. Jasper Sipes came before the board and requested that the board take an advertisement in the School Herald and on the pages of the pamphlets containing the School Laws he proposed that for the last advertising the board pay \$2.50 per month to the present date, and for future advertising \$5.00 per month, which was laid on the table.

Pres. Boyd made his report in which he recommended that the board appropriate from University funds for maintenance of the Laboratory & furniture for same \$500.00, Physiology & Psychology \$300.00, President's Office \$50.00, Physics 850.00.

Upon motion of Mr. Maxey there was appropriated \$400.00 for the library and maintenance of same, and \$300.00 Physiology & Psychology, and for furniture for the President's office \$50.00/

Upon motion of Mr. McGuire there was appropriated \$850.00 for the Physical & Chemical Dpt. to be used for the coming year.

Mr. Earhart's bill for labor, allowed, \$4.00

The Board listened to Prof. DeBarr's remarks as to his requirements for the following year.

Mr. Anderson also came before the board and complained that his salary was not sufficient on account of his warrants not being worth par but that he had to discount his salary at 90¢ on a dollar.

The Board then went into an executive session.

Mr. McGuire moved that the present faculty be retained, except Prof. Anderson.

Moved that Mr. DeBarr has an increase of salary of \$100.00. Elder \$1200.00.

Adjourned to July 15" 1896.
