

BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA


A meeting of the Board of Regents was held on Monday, February 23, 1925, at 9:00 a. m. in the office of Frank Buttram, vice-chairman of the Board, Braniff Building, Oklahoma City. Regent McDonald, Chairman of the Board, presided; others present: Regents Buttram, Bowman, Schwoerke, Highley, Rogers.

The minutes of the meeting held November 8, 1924, were approved as printed.

The Board discussed the appropriations for the University for the coming biennium, bills for which are pending in the legislature.

The presidency of the University was taken up, and upon motion by Regent Rogers, which was duly seconded and passed, the chair was authorized to appoint a committee of three for the purpose of interviewing several men whom the Board felt would be qualified for the position, and report back at a later meeting of the Board. The following were appointed to serve on the committee: Regents Buttram, Rogers, Highley.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
