Board of Regents of the University of Oklahoma.

A meeting of the Board of Regents was held on Monday, June 6, 1927, at 10:00 a. m., in the office of the President of the University, at Norman. Frank Buttram, Chairman of the Board, presided. Others present: Regents Rogers, McDonald, Carlock, Lowther, Looney, Kite. Regent Kite was appointed by Governor Johnston to fill the vacancy caused by the expiration of the term of George L. Bowman.

Chapter 68, House Bill No. 46, Session Laws of 1927, and approved by the Governor on March 23, 1927, automatically retired all members of the Board of Regents. All members were reappointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate, the terms of appointments being as indicated below:

Joseph C. Looney, term expires March 24, 1928. W. C. Kite, term expires March 24, 1929. A. A. McDonald, term expires March 24, 1930. John P. Rogers, term expires March 24, 1931. John H. Carlock, term expires March 24, 1932. Addie Lee Lowther, term expires March 24, 1935. Frank Buttram, term expires March 24, 1934.

On account of the technicality due to the above legislative action, an election of officers was held. Frank Buttram was reelected Chairman of the Board and John Rogers was reelected Vice-Chairman.

The minutes of the meeting of March 9, 1927, were approved as printed.

I recommend that the President of the University be authorized to waive the non-resident tuition fee for graduate students appointed to fellowships and scholarships in the University of Oklahoma.

The salary budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1927 and ending June 30, 1928, was approved subject to modifications, the total to come within the appropriations made by the legislature.

President Bizzell made the suggestion that a portrait in oil be made of Governor Henry S. Johnston, and that it be hung in the library with similar portraits of former governors of the State. President Bizzell was authorized to employ Professor Gimeno to make the portrait at a cost not to exceed \$100.00.

The following regulations regarding travel and the payment of traveling expenses for members of the administrative staff and faculty of the University were adopted.

Regulation Governing Traveling Expenses

Passed by the Board of Regents, June 6, 1927.

 \bigvee For purposes of administration, official trips by administrative officers and members of the teaching staff of the University of Oklahoma shall be classified as follows:

1. Official occasions, such as academic inaugurations, meetings of the North Central Association of Colleges and Preparatory Schools and similar educational conferences, where it is customary to appoint a delegate to represent the entire University. The total expenses of the delegate to the meetings coming under this classification may be paid by the University with the Understanding that the President shall designate the official delegate.

2. Meetings of learned societies which are of peculiar interest to some particular department where the benefits accrue jointly to the individual representative and to a particular school or department in the University. Representatives to conventions coming under this classification shall be entitled only to their actual traveling expenses provided the total does not exceed \$100. When the total traveling expenses

exceed this sum the representative shall bear half the excess in addition to his hotel and other expenses.

3. Conventions of a general character where it is important for a University to be represented but it is not of peculiar or special importance to any one department. All or part of the expenses of a delegate to any convention coming under this classification may be authorized by the President of the University, as circumstances may seem advisable.

No expense for travel outside of the State shall be incurred by any employee of the University unless a written request shall be made for permission to incur said expense and previous to leaving Norman or Oklahoma City the absentee shall have the written approval from the President of the University.

The following resolution concerning the Oklahoma Geological Survey was adopted:

WHEREAS, the law places the government and control of the Oklahoma Geological Survey under the Board of Regents of the University of Oklahoma:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That in the administration of the said Survey, the Director shall bear the same relation to the President of the University as the deans of the several schools and colleges in the University, and;

That all communications and recommendations to the Board of Regents from the Director, and all communications and recommendations from the Board of Regents to the Director, shall be transmitted through the President of the University of Oklahoma.

On recommendation of Dr. A. Richards, head of the Department of Zoology, President Bizzell presented the request that a Biological Survey for the purpose of studying biological resources of Oklahoma be established under the direction of the University of Oklahoma. It was recommended that for the present a simple type of organization be formulated, involving the appointment of a director, a curator of vertebrates, a curator of invertebrates, a botanist, a museum assistant and such clerical assistants as may be necessary. The recommendation was approved.

On recommendation of Dr. A. B. Adams, Dean of the School of Business, President Bizzell requested that there be established under the auspices of the School of Business of the University of Oklahoma, a Bureau of Business Research, the immediate project to be undertaken to include a study of the current business and economic problems confronting the petroleum industry. It was pointed out by Dr. Adams that the establishment of this bureau would not entail the expenditure of additional money at this time, but that the teaching force of the faculty of the School of Business would be used to carry on the work of the bureau. The recommendation was approved.

On recommendation of John Alley, head of the Department of Government, President Bizzell presented the request that there be established as a separate

school within the College of Arts and Sciences, a School of Citizenship. The recommendation was approved.

Reverend F. M. Shelton, of the Board of Trustees of Kingfisher College, requested that the Board of Regents nominate two people of whom Kingfisher College trustees would select one as a member of a board of nine trustees to have charge of the affairs of Kingfisher College, the election to be for a term of three years. The Board of Regents nominated C. C. Roberts and H. V. L. Sapper, both of whom are graduates of the University of Oklahoma, and the Secretary was instructed to notify Reverend Shelton accordingly.

President Bizzell requested the opinion of the Board on the policy of paying traveling expenses of employees of other State institutions when working in cooperation with the University Extension Department. It was the sense of the Board that when such work is done under the direction of the University Extension Department, the payment of such expenses would be justifiable.

Chapter 212, Senate Joint Resolution No. 3, session laws of 1927, making an appropriation of \$250,000 for a Medical School building at Oklahoma City, provides that the Board of Regents of the University of Oklahoma let a contract for the construction and equipping of the said building. It was voted that Layton, Hicks and Forsythe be designated as architects for this building and that they be instructed to prepare plans and specifications.

On motion adjourned.
