President Bizzell presented for consideration the question of promotion of J. H. Marshburn, Associate Professor of English. It was voted that he be promoted to the rank of Professor and that he be placed upon the salary schedule beginning September 1, 1928, at \$3,400, this being an increase of \$200 in salary.

Carl Giles acting as agent in the proposed purchase of land for additions to the campus, going before the Board with a statement concerning options he had secured, stated that he had secured an option on a one acre tract from W. W. McCullough, at a price of \$1,500; also one from Everett DeGolyer of \$18,000 net on his eight acre tract and that Mrs. Bee M. Barry had made a price

of \$45,000 on her five acre tract, including improvements.

It was voted to purchase the one acre tract from Mr. McCullough, using a part of the funds appropriated during the eleventh Legislature for the purpose of buying additional land. Also that the balance of this fund be used in purchasing a part of the DeGolyer tract. The balance to be purchased by Mr. Buttram and held until the next session of the Legislature, at which time an effort would be made to secure additional appropriations to purchase the land. Mr. Buttram agreed to advance the money for this purpose, interest at the rate of six per cent.

Mr. Giles was instructed to complete the details of this transaction and to confer with Mrs. Barry with reference to her property and then make a report to President Bizzell.

President Bizzell brought up for consideration the question of remuneration for members of the Medical School Faculty during the summer while transferring equipment to Oklahoma City. The President was instructed to notify the Medical Faculty that no funds were available for this purpose.

The Building Program for the biennium beginning July 1, 1921 and closing June 30, 1931 was discussed. President Bizzell recommended that the following buildings be included in the budget to be presented to the Legislature:

It was the sense of the Board that while all of these items are urgently needed it probably will not be possible to secure appropriations covering the entire program. President Bizzell was authorized to include the items in the budget.

President Bizzell reported that the Administrative Council had voted to organize a General Faculty and on recommendation of the President this action was confirmed.
