Motion made that C. L. Botsford and President Boyd be appointed a Committe to rent additional room for gymnasium and School of Music.

Carried.

Motion made that C. L. Botsford be appointed to ascertain from the business men the amount of money they are willing to give for the twenty acres of ground lying east of the present University grounds and to offer to the owner thereof such amount, and in case of the owner refusing such offer, then Mr. Botsford is to notify Mr. Asp, who is hereby authorized to institute the proper and legal proceedings to condemn said land.

On motion the Board adjourned to July 5th, 1901, at the office of Governor Wm M. Jenkins, in the city of Guthrie.
