The Board of Regents met pursuant to adjournment at 10 A.M. at the office of President Asp, in Guthrie, Oklahoma.

Present H. E. Asp, President, Hon. W. M. Jenkins, Governor, R. E. Wood, G. W. Sutton, C. O. Blake.

D. L. Larsh presented his commission of appointment as Regent, by the Governor of Oklahoma, vice C. L. Botsford, resigned, and qualified by subscribing to required oath. Upon motion D. L. Larsh was elected Secretary of the Board to fill vacancy caused by resignation of Mr. Botsford.

The Board directed that its previous action relative to employing an Assistant in Chemistry be ratified, and that the President of the University be authorized to report the name of a suitable person for the position.

Moved by Sutton, that the chair in connection with the architect, be authorized to take such steps as may be deemed necessary for the protection of contractors in the purchase of building material for the proposed new college building.
