Renfrow for a detail to give instructions in the University.

Upon motion of Mr. Wheeler, Prof. Boyd was instructed to employ Prof. Waugh of the A & M College to lecture at the University not paying him more than his expenses.

Upon motion of Col. Leavy, Pres. Boyd was instructed to straighten the drive from Norman leading to the University.
