The Regents met at University office at 9 am pursuant to call

D L Larsh Secty

The Minutes of Meetings of Sept 13th and 15th were read and ordered approved.

Petitions of students J W Field and Roy Hadsell asking that they be allowed remuneration at the rate of one dollar per column for University News items reported to the Daily Press, was granted, until otherwise directed by the Regents

The Secty presented Bond filed by the Springfield Plumbing Co., Executed by the City Trust Safe Deposit & Surety Co. of Philadelphia, in the sum of 5300.00, which the Regents directed be not approved. and the Secty was ordered to return same to Heating Contractors with the request that a new Bond be filed in Double the amt of contract as required by the statute.

Bids were then opened for the Lighting Plant for the University, as per advertisements. One bid being filed only by Arnold & Weatherly of Oklahoma City. Same being 3800.00 for the Equipment of the Lighting plans per plans & specifications.

The amount of Bid appearing to the Regents As Excessive, and not within the limits that cared to Expend for the purpose, Upon Motion duly seconded and Carried the Bid was rejected.

Upon Motion the Secty was directed to Confer with Architect A J Williams, and if if in their Judgment deemed best, to readvertise for Bids.

Upon Motion duly made, Seconded and Carried, the aftermentioned payments, made to Contractors Rowles & Bailey and Arthur J. Williams, Architect, by the President & Secty, were ratified and Confirmed and the action of the President & Secty in issuing warrants on Building fund, therefor, was adopted as the Action of the Regents as of the dates upon which said warrants were issued- Towit
