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Claims of Springfield Plumbing Co for amount due them on Superintendents Estimate No#1 on Heating Contract, was also allowed and the ______ of Building fund warrant No 35 dated Nov 11, 1902 for 2,231.40 in payment of same, was ratified and confirmed as the action of the Board as of the date same was issued by the President & Secretary.

Upon recommendation of President D R Boyd the Regents authorized the Employment of Maxwell Phillips as Instructor in Spanish at a salary of 20.00 per month for 10 months from Sept 1, 1902.

Regents Wilkin & Larsh were approinted as committee to Equip new Building with necessary Blackboards.

The Matter of Lighting Buildings with Electricity was again considered, but upon motion action on same was deferred to a future meeting.

Regents Wilkin & Larsh were appointed committee to consult with Architect Williams relative to substitution of Floor tiling for the floor lights. in the Main Building. This being done at suggestion of Contractors Rowles & Bailey who recommend the changes as being to the advantage of the University.

The Secty submitted surety Bond for approval, filed by the Springfield Plumbing Co. on their Heating Contract with the Regents said Bond being in the sum of \$10600.00 and made by the City Trust, Safe Deposit and Surety Co of Philadelphia. Said bond, being considered good and sufficient, it was upon, motion, approved and the Secty authorized to return the Certified Check 99.80 which was filed with the Regents by said contractors when submitting their bid on the Heating job.

The Secty reported to the Regents that he had filed claim for \$1820.67 against the AT&SFRR for Rebates of one Half Frt. rate on Brick shipped from Cherryvale and Fredonio as per agreement with Contractors Rowles & Bailey.

The Regents then prepared the Biennial Report to the Governor, as required by law and directed same be forwarded under signature of the President.
