

SPECIAL MEETING
REGENTS, UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA
TUESDAY, MAY 27, 1952
9:30 A.M.

On call by Governor Johnston Murray, the Regents met in the Governor's office at 9:30 a.m. on Tuesday, May 27, 1952; all members being present. President Cross was also present.

The meeting was called by the Governor to report to the Regents on the Investigation made by George Howard Wilson, Special Investigator for the Governor, on Dr. Richard Blanc, Assistant Professor of Zoology in the University since September, 1946.

Following the meeting with the Governor, the Regents met in the Blue Room, State Capitol.

President Cross asked that he be given instructions on the matter.

Following a discussion, Regent Benedum moved, and it was unanimously voted, "that Dr. Cross confer with Dr. Blanc and give him an opportunity to resign his assistant professorship in the University of Oklahoma at his earliest convenience; if Dr. Blanc does not resign by Monday, then the Regents will meet on Commencement Day, June 2."

The meeting was adjourned at 12:40 p.m.
