## MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 20, 1952 - 10:00 A. M.

A Special Meeting of the Regents of the University of Oklahoma was held at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, November 20, 1952, in the office of the President of the University, Norman.

The following were present: Regent White, President, presiding; Benedum, Short, Morgan, Little. Absent: Foster, McBride.

The meeting was called to discuss further the matter of a bowl game in the light of developments since the regular meeting on November 13, at which time the Regents voted to leave the decision as to whether a bowl bid would be accepted to the coaching staff and the team.

Mr. Wilkinson was called to the meeting. Mr. Wilkinson reported he had informed the team of the Regents' action, and also explained the Conference regulations. He stated the team would like very much to play in a bowl game, but would not want to do anything to jeopardize the athletic program or act in any way other than the best interests of the University.

The matter was fully discussed.

Regent Morgan moved as follows: "Since we have always followed the regulations of the Conference to which we belong, we shall continue to do so."

A vote was called for on the motion and all members voted AYE except Regent Little who requested that he be recorded as voting NO.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
