

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING
BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA
MONDAY, MAY 4, 1959 - 2:00 P.M.

A special meeting of the Board of Regents was called by the President of the Board, W. D. Grisso, with the following members present: Regents Benedum, Savage, Northcutt.

ABSENT: Regents Morgan and McBride.

Dr. Pete Kyle McCarter, Vice President of the University, attended the meeting in the absence of President Cross.

The Chair announced that the meeting was called in response to a petition filed by two students, Tom Cox and Ronnie L. Dombek, requesting consideration by the Regents on action by the Student Advisory Judicial Board by which the students were given a penalty of suspension from the University to January 1, 1960. Another student, Linda Sue Moye, and a non-student woman were involved in the incident. Miss Moye was given the same penalty as the two men.

The petition by Tom Cox and Ronnie L. Dombek was read, and the matter was discussed.


Following the discussion Regent Northcutt made the following motion:

"That the action of the Student Advisory Judicial Board suspending Tom Cox, Ronnie L. Dombek, and Linda Sue Moye, for a period ending January 1, 1960, be set aside and that the students be permitted to continue in the University under restrictive probation until the opening of the fall semester of the 1959-60 school term, and that they be continued on general probation for an additional school year."

The motion was seconded by Regent Savage. All members voted AYE on the motion and it was declared carried.

It was agreed that the matter of disciplinary regulations in general be placed on the agenda for the July meeting of the Regents.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
