

Achievement Level Frequencies* Fall 2014 – Fall 2017 * Through Sept 30, 2017





Achievement Level Frequencies* Fall 2014 – Spring 2018








Engagement by Participant Type




Engagement by Class Standing




Engagement by First Generation Status




Effect of Age on Student Engagement




Engagement by Race/Ethnicity




Effect of Cumulative GPA on Engagement




Student Engagement by College
