


### Help

- 1. Every student at the University of Central Oklahoma can design and create their own Student Transformative Learning Record to reflect their individual achievements in UCO's Central 6 Tenets of Transformative Learning. However, the tenet of Discipline Knowledge is not available here, since that is already display on your traditional academic transcript.
- 2. Within this tool, you will be prompted to select the tenets you wish to display and in what order you would like to see them displayed. It is wise to consider the future use of your record (job application, resume attachment, interview preparation tool or personal reminder of learning). For example, if you are applying for a job where international experiences will be included, you may want to strategically list achievements in Global & Cultural Competencies at the top of your record.
- 3. You do not have to list all tenets on your record, and we recommend you do not list tenets where you do not have achievements.
- 4. Once you have selected your tenets, you will see your comprehensive list of achievements at exposure, integration and transformation within each tenet. You may select up to five achievements to show in the detailed view of your record and you can place these in any order you choose. If you have achieved at the transformation level, we recommend you place this/these achievement(s) at the top of your list.
- 5. Once you select your achievements to include in the record, you will be given an opportunity to preview your record and either submit or continue to edit.
- 6. You can create as many versions of your record as you need. The tool will prompt you to save and you can name the version of the record in a format that makes the most sense to you. Keep in mind that your achievement data is updated each 24 hours, so what you see reflected in the achievements list should be comprehensive and up to date.








## **Comprehensive Student** Record (CSR) Diagram




### Title III Target Population\* Semester GPA by STLR Involvement






Work with employers: Our STLR Employer Advisory Board has provided critical CSR input.



# Semester GPA\* by STLR Engagement Title III Target Population\*\* First-Time Freshman







STLR composite score is calculated by awarding 1, 2, and 10 points per activity for exposure, integration, and transformation, respectively. The score is cumulative over semesters and thus represents the STLR activity each student engaged in Fall 2015 and Spring 2016.



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
