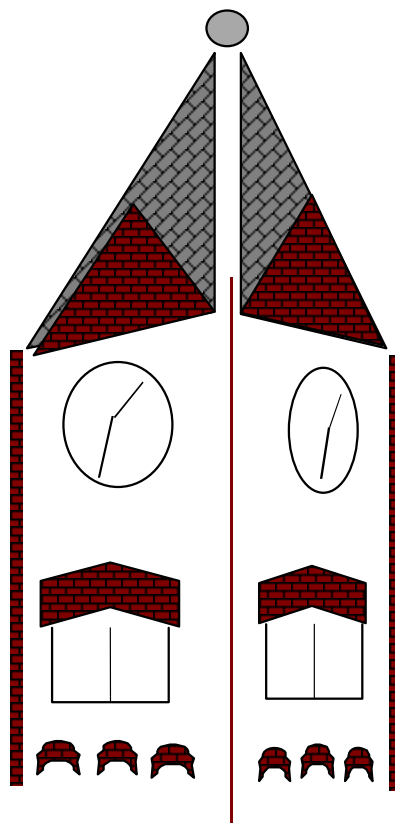

# Warning to Data Users

[Broncho Analytics](#) provides data users with the most current institutional data available from the Office of Institutional Research. These data reflect our efforts to correct for a number of data quality issues in the student information system & provide comparable time-series data. As we have transitioned to reporting from a data warehouse, our methods have evolved. Unfortunately, this might mean a report from many years ago is no longer comparable with data reported currently on Broncho Analytics. For example, past reports on student majors were based on the student's "primary major" whereas current major reports are not limited in this way.

Data users are encouraged to consult the Office of Institutional Research when comparing data from past editions of the Factbook and Demobook to current reports on [Broncho Analytics](#).

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# INTRODUCTION

This document is intended to serve managers in their decision making processes. There has been an effort to use data that is consistent from one semester to the same semester the next year. Where possible, trend information is provided.

FTE numbers may vary slightly because of automatic rounding by the computer. Student credit hours are sorted two ways: by student classification (for FTE calculations) or by course level (for production by department). The data sections for each college do not include students with undeclared majors or with invalid major codes.

The following bullets provide some information you may want to keep in mind while reviewing the Demographics Book:

- The increase in undeclared students results in fewer majors within each college. Students are not associated with a college until they declare a major. There is a section of reports to show the statistics for these students.
- There is a report to track students on campus by time of day. Students enrolled in institutes, independent studies, etc., are not included. Students may be counted in more than one category or college.
- Due to restructuring, Interdisciplinary Studies was added in Fall 2009. It contains the Forensic Science Institute as well as those hours generated through First-Year Experience and Leadership.

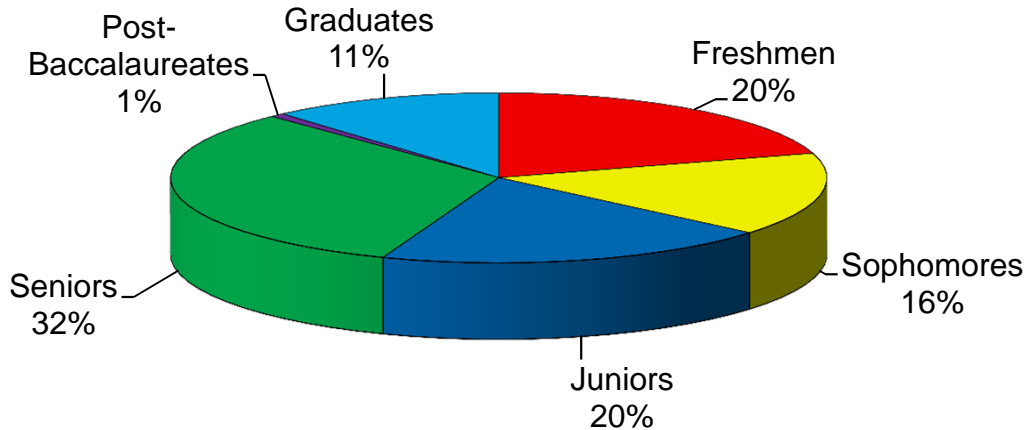
Due to the block scheduling, which allows some classes to have a later enrollment period, the summer semester is the least consistent of the three semesters in terms of preliminary enrollment numbers. The data in this book is accurate as of January 17, 2012. End of semester figures (which vary slightly from these) are transmitted to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education for Unitized Data Reporting and for input into the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS). This serves as a major database for higher education statistics.

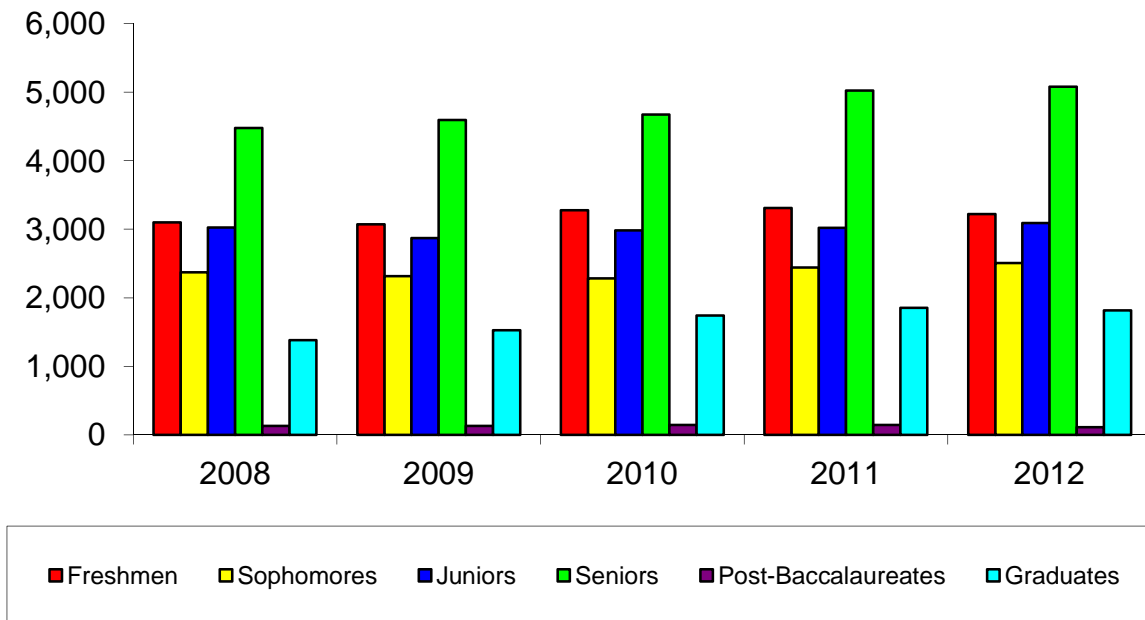
Percentage of Total Headcount - Spring 2012

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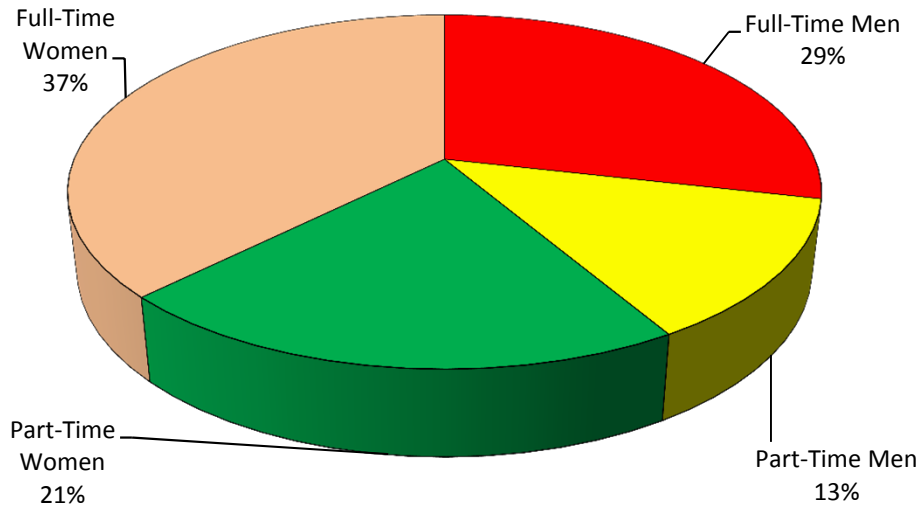

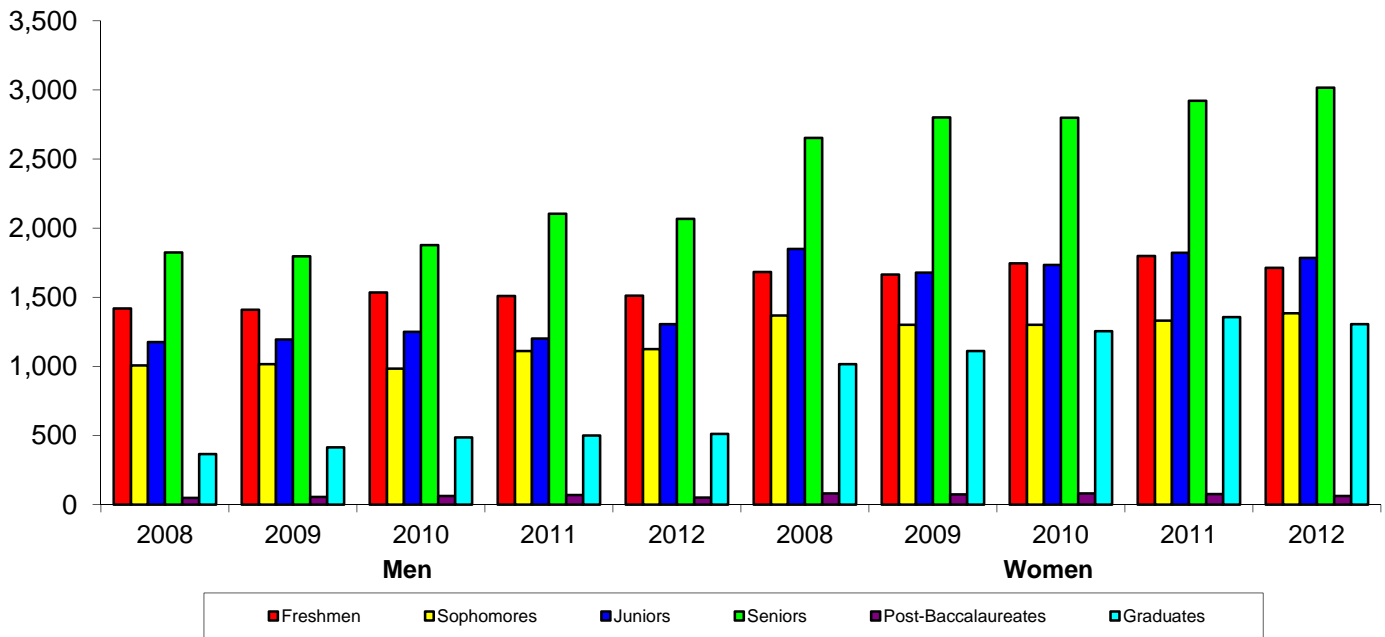
**Gender and Full/Part-Time Status**

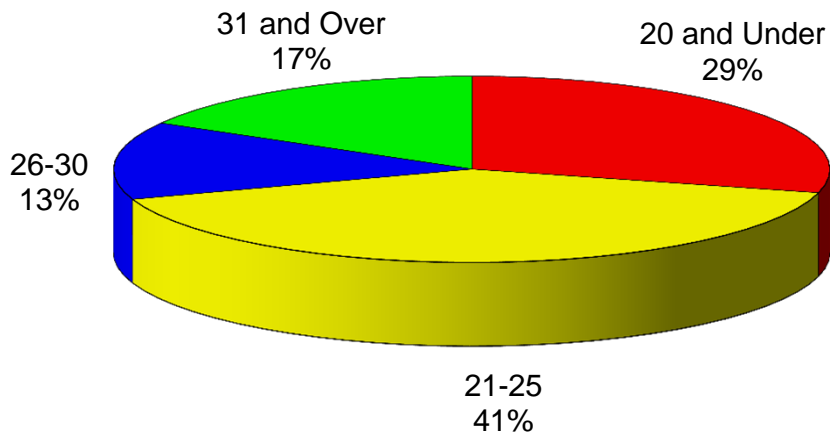
### Men/Women Comparison

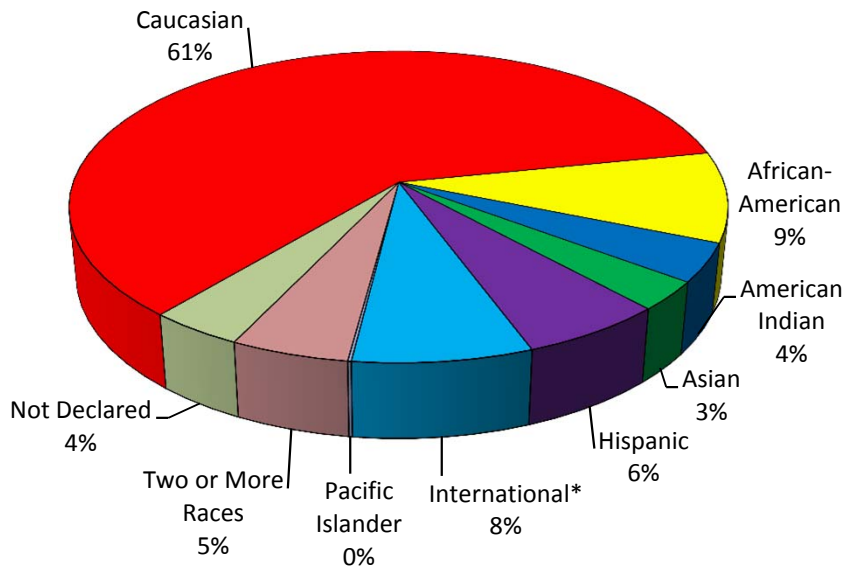

### Ethnicity Comparison



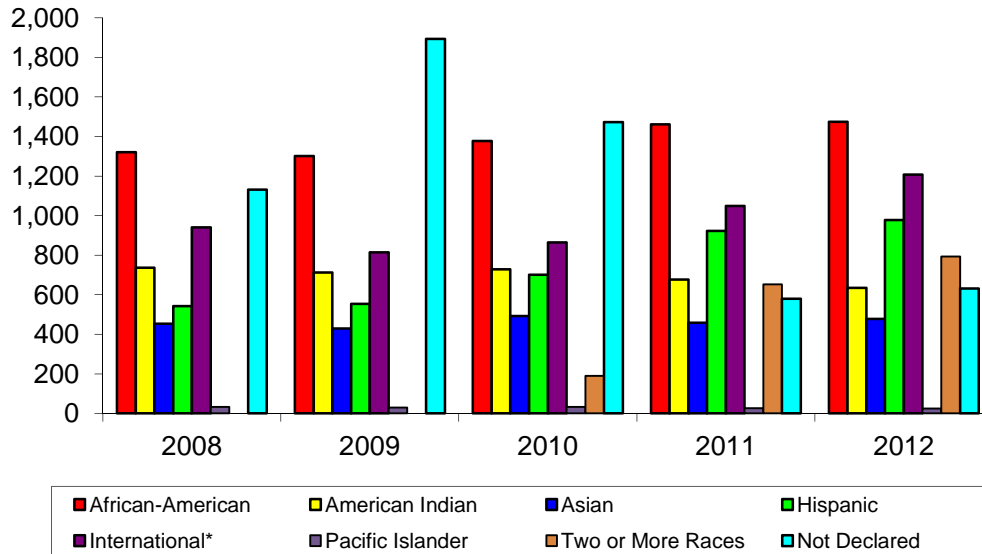

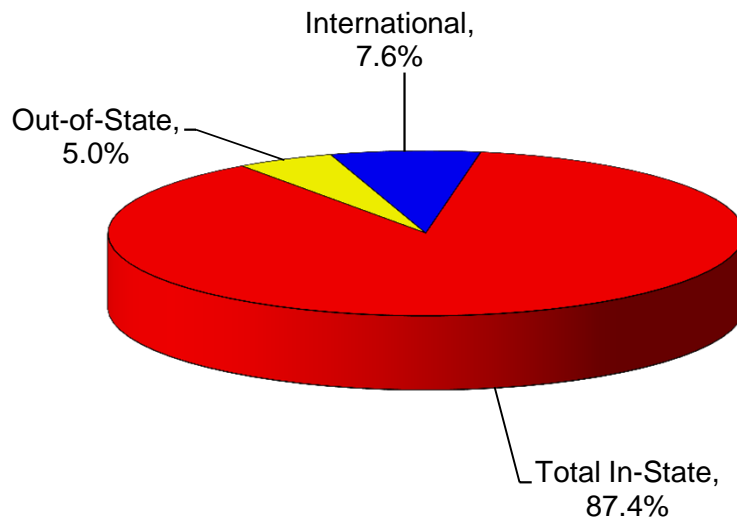
### Ethnicity Comparison

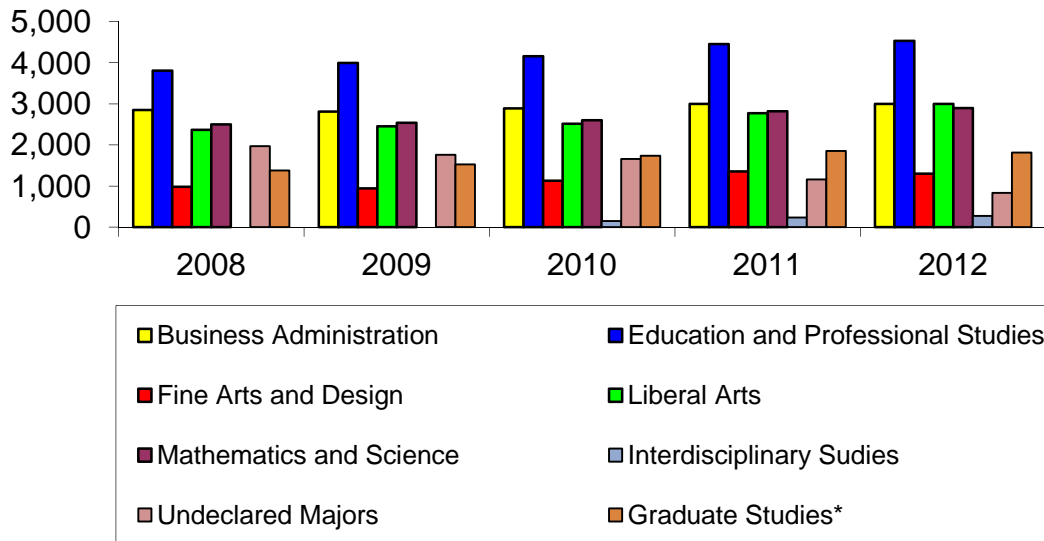

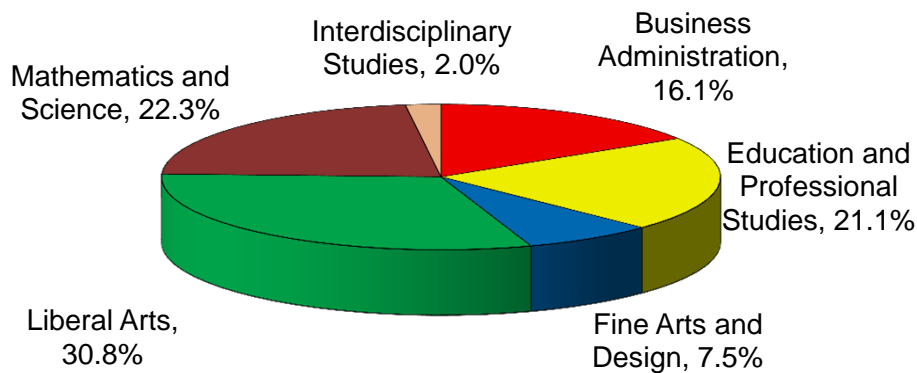

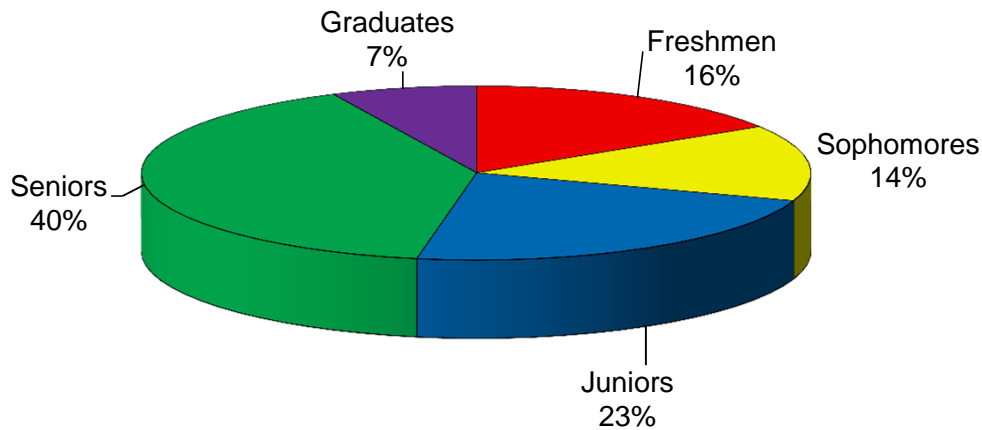

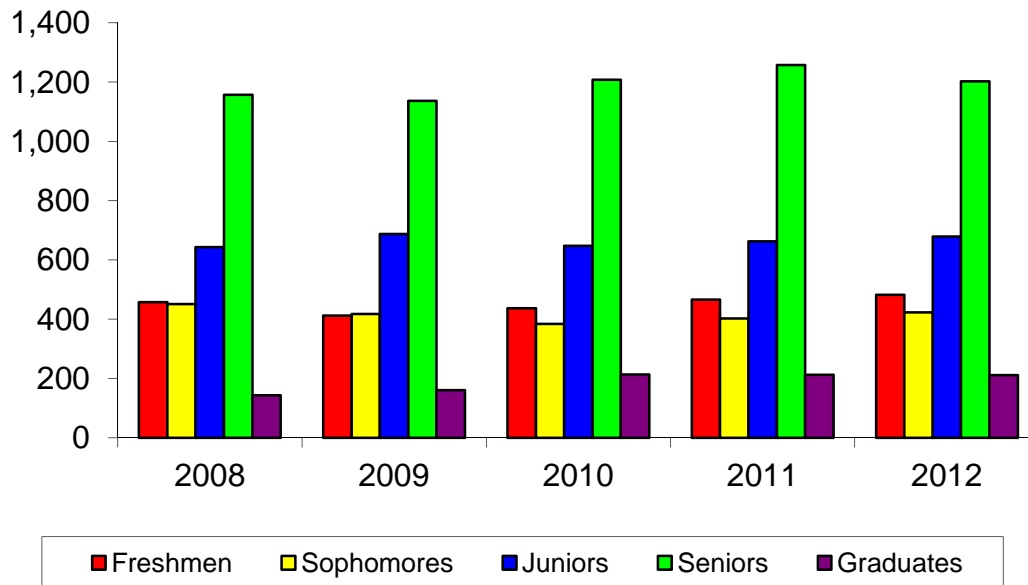
### Percentage of Total Headcount - Spring 2012

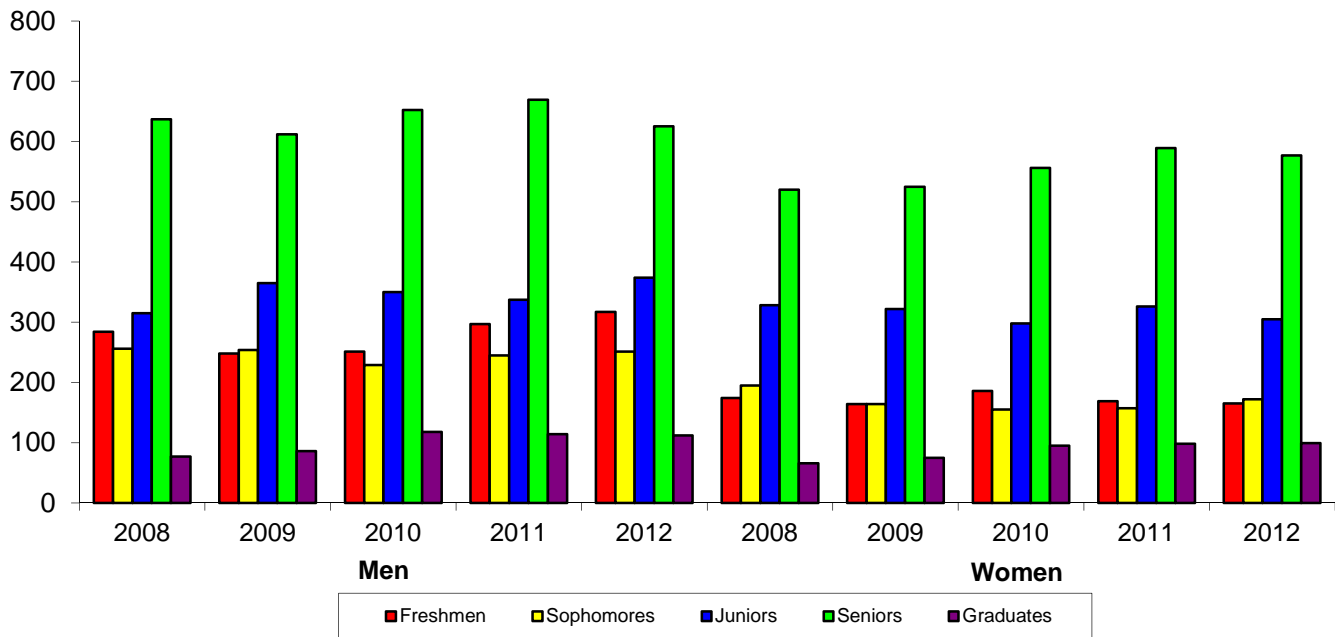

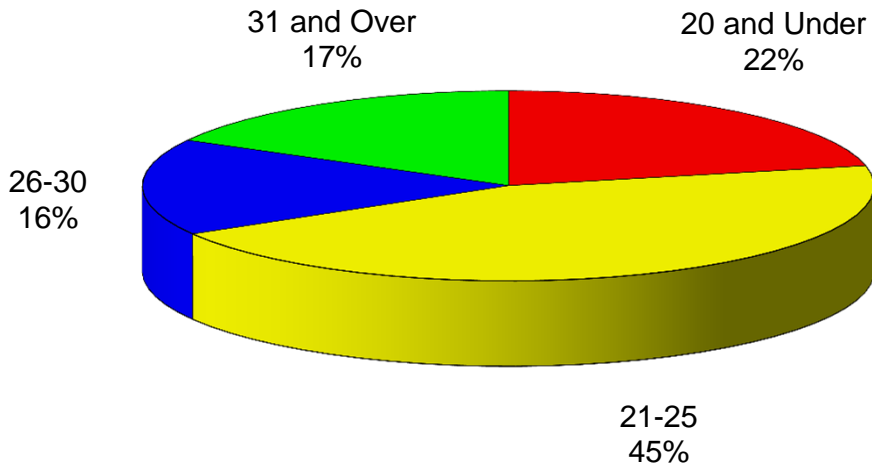

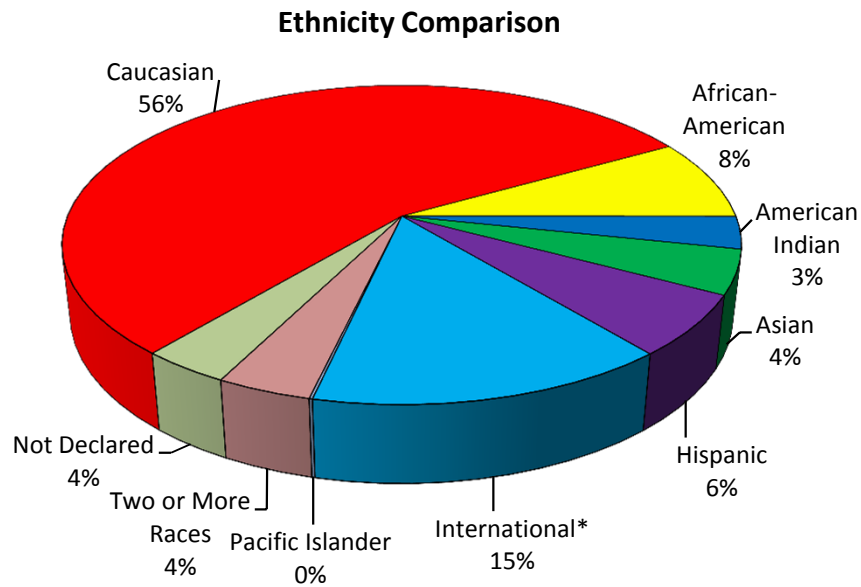
**Age Distribution - Spring 2012**

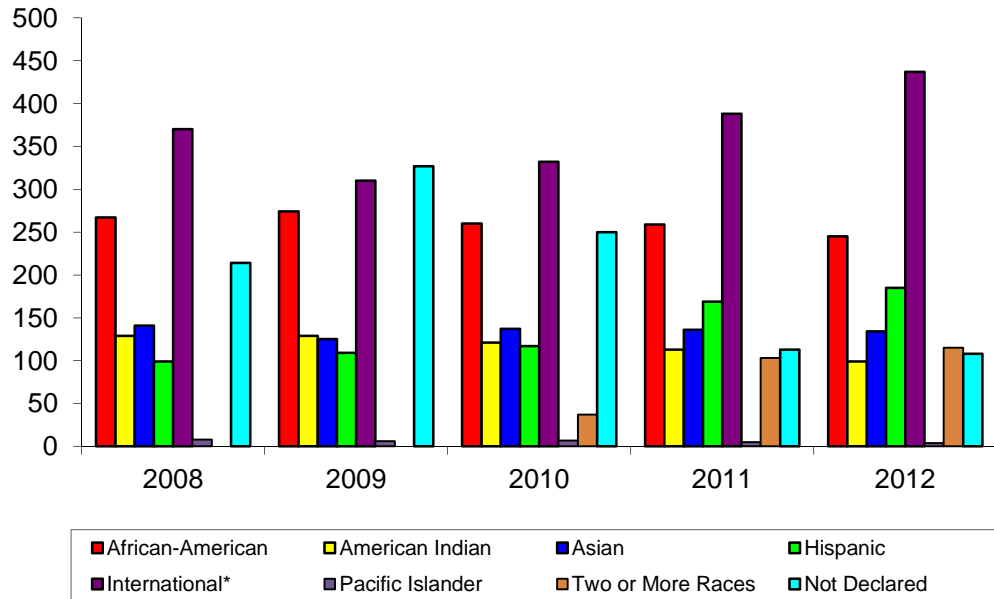

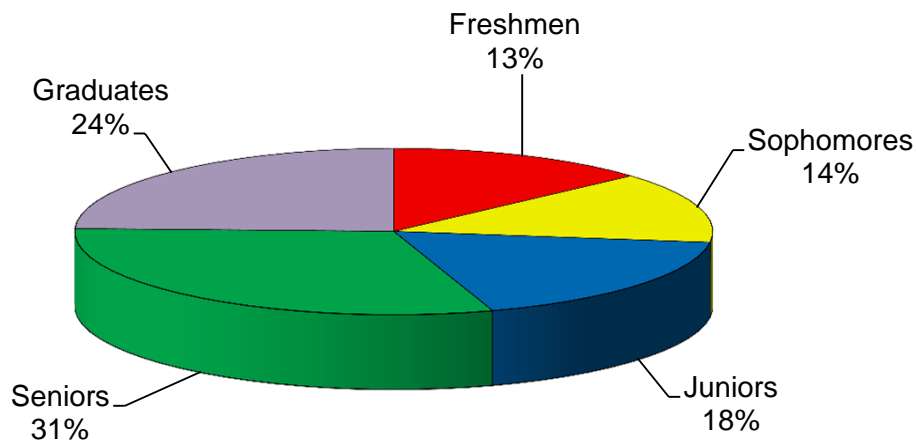

### Percentage of Total Headcount - Spring 2012

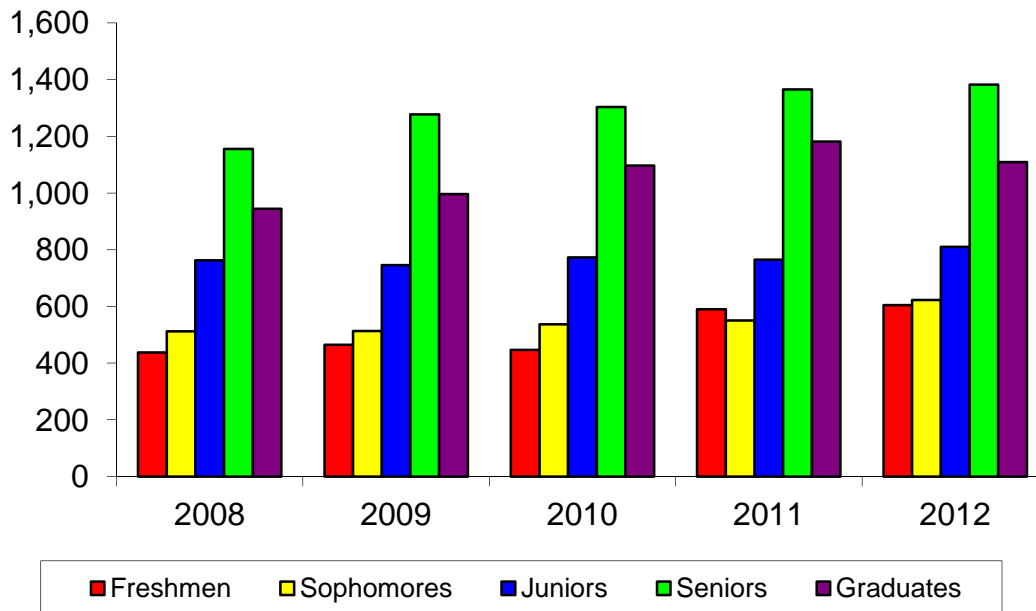

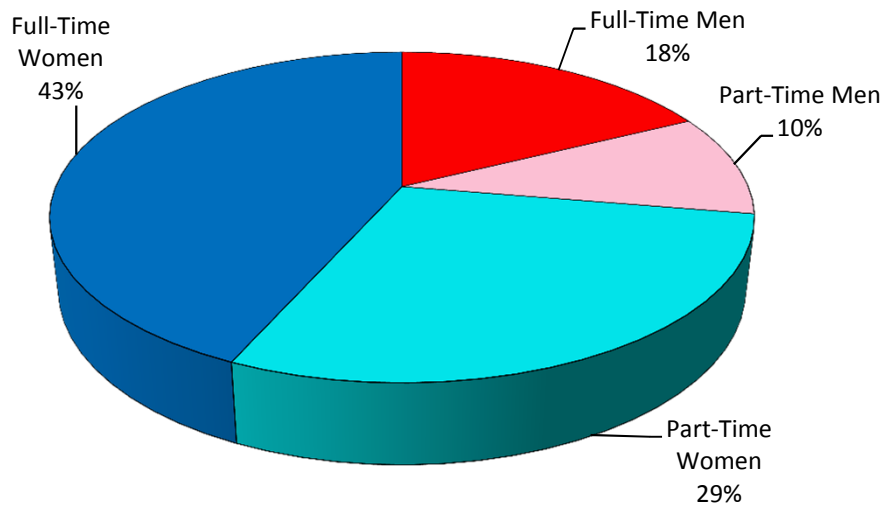

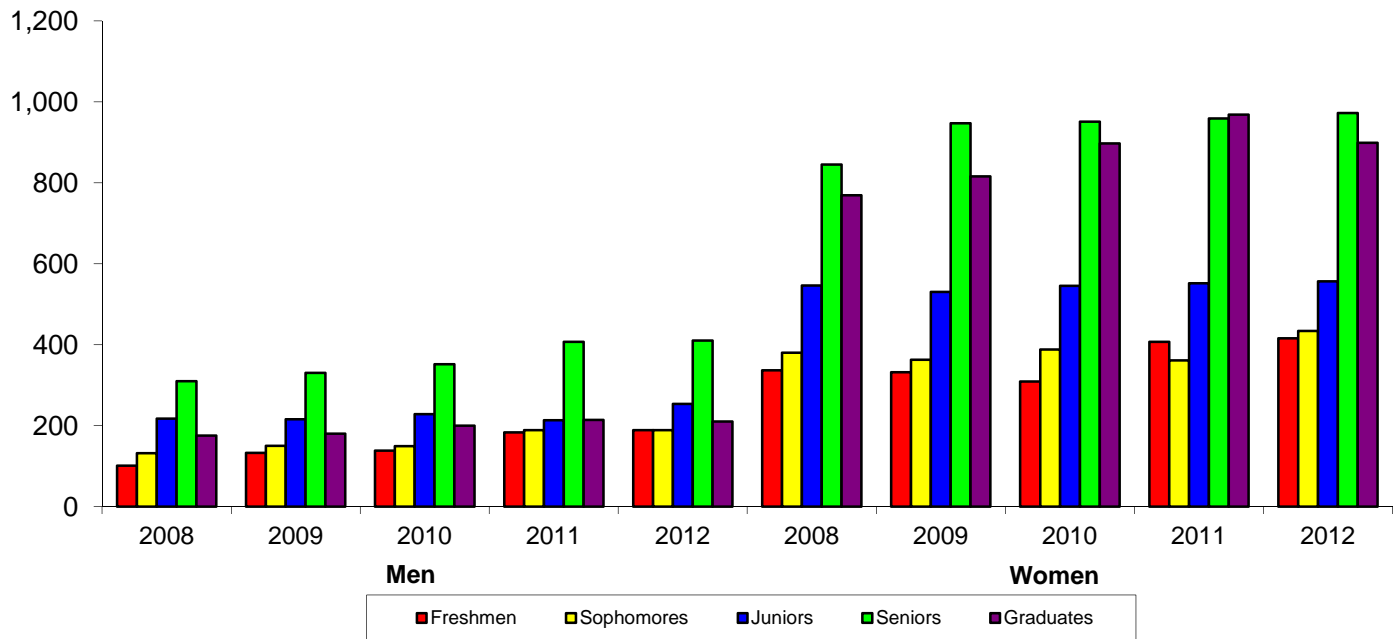
**Gender and Full/Part-Time Status**

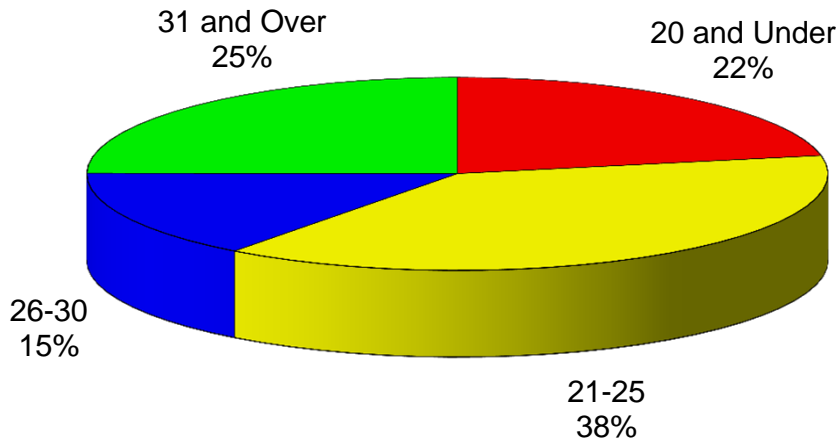

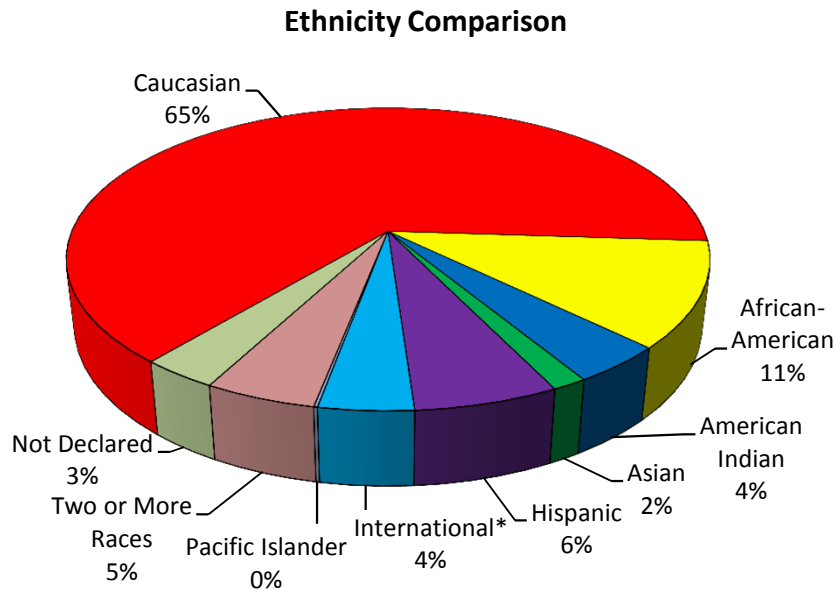

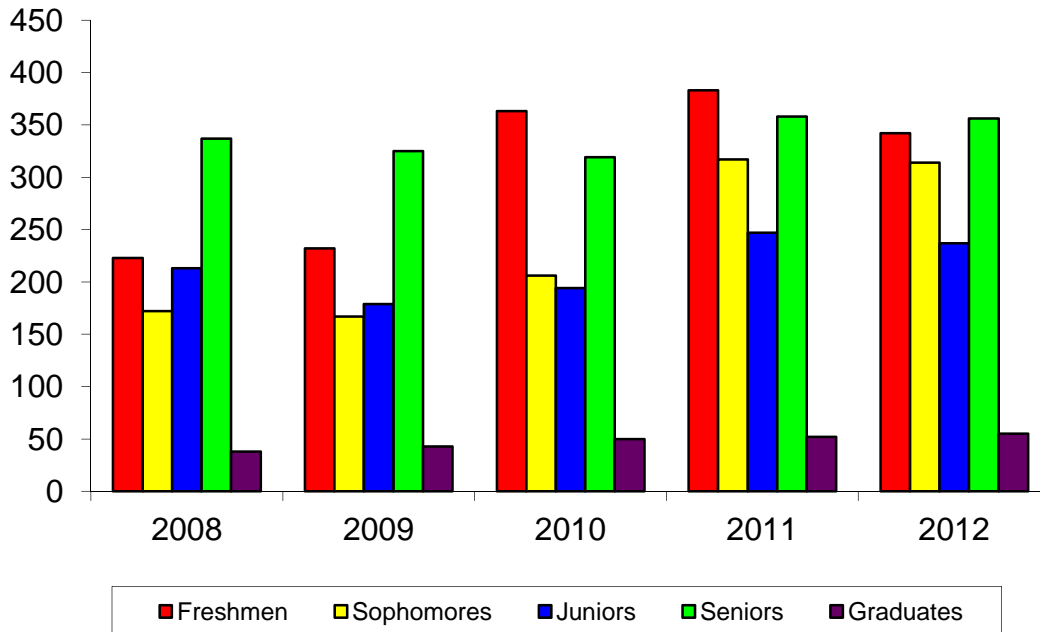
### Percentage of Total Headcount - Spring 2012

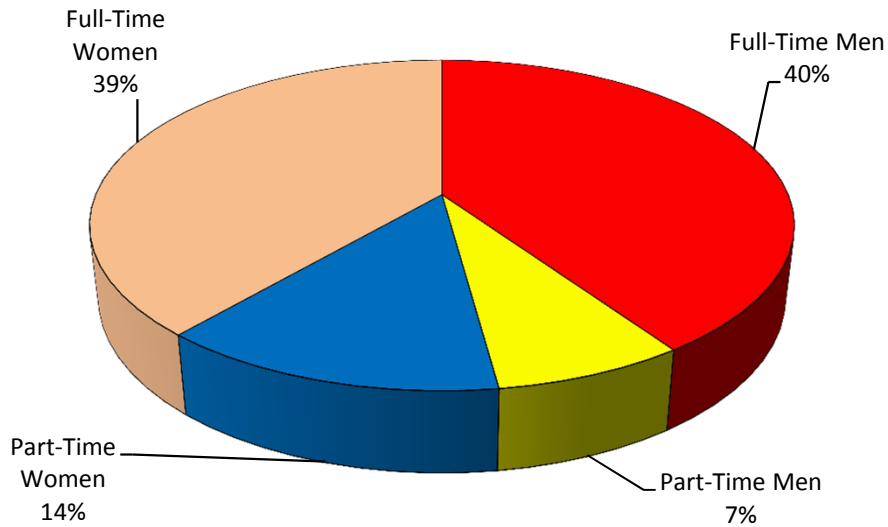

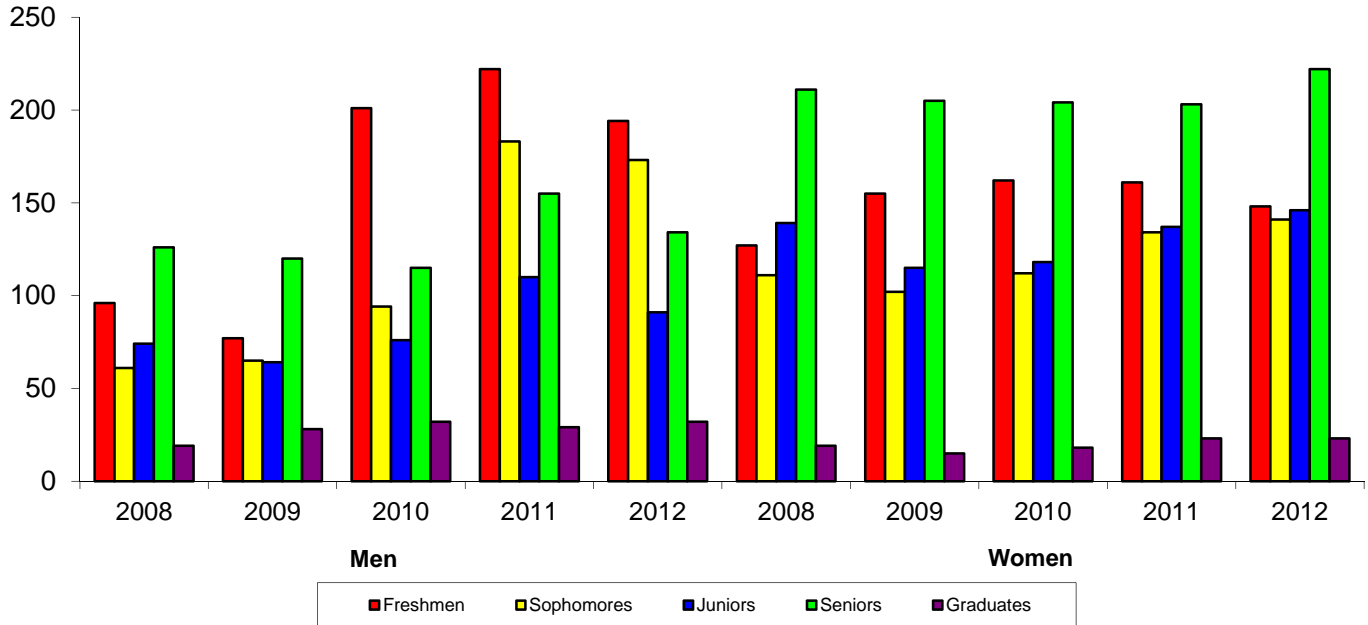
**Gender and Full/Part-Time Status**

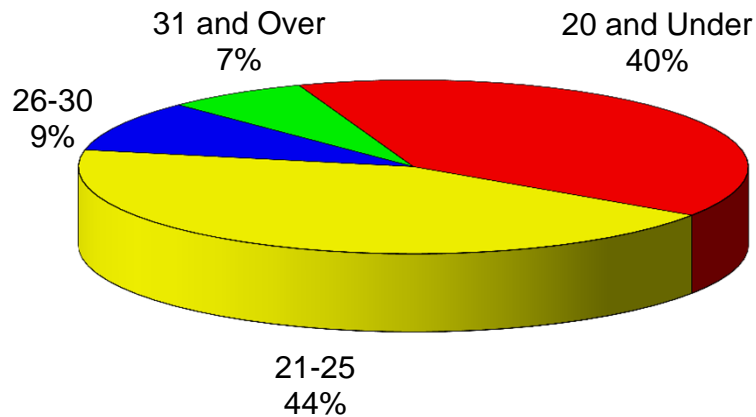

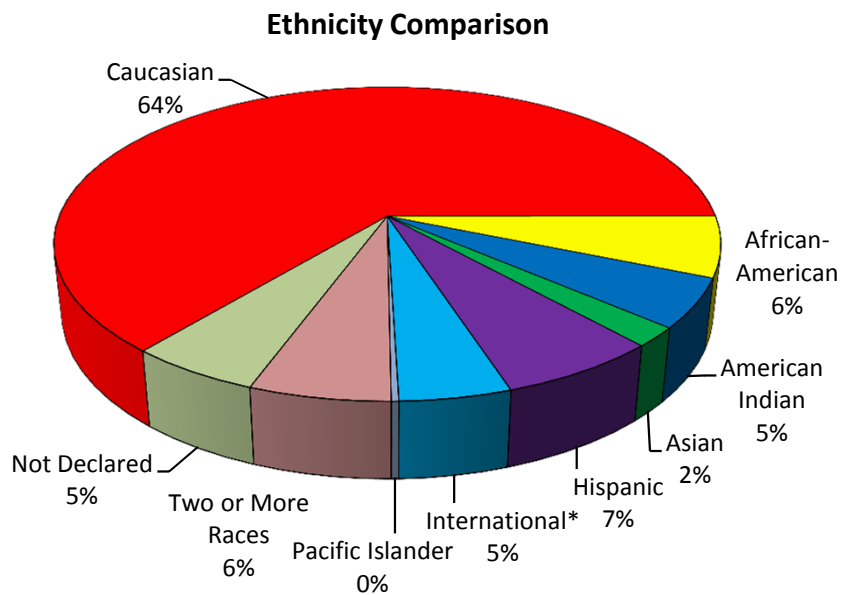
**Age Distribution - Spring 2012**

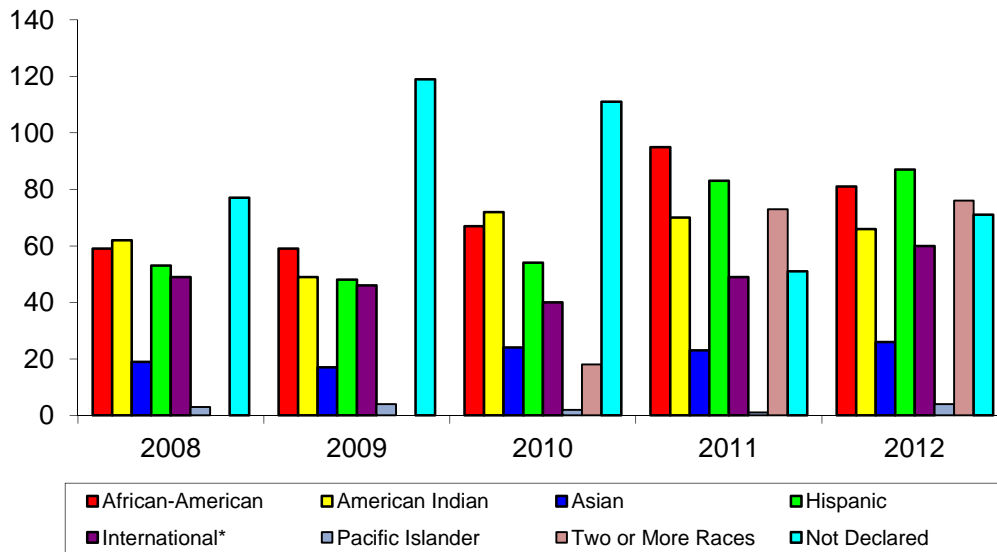

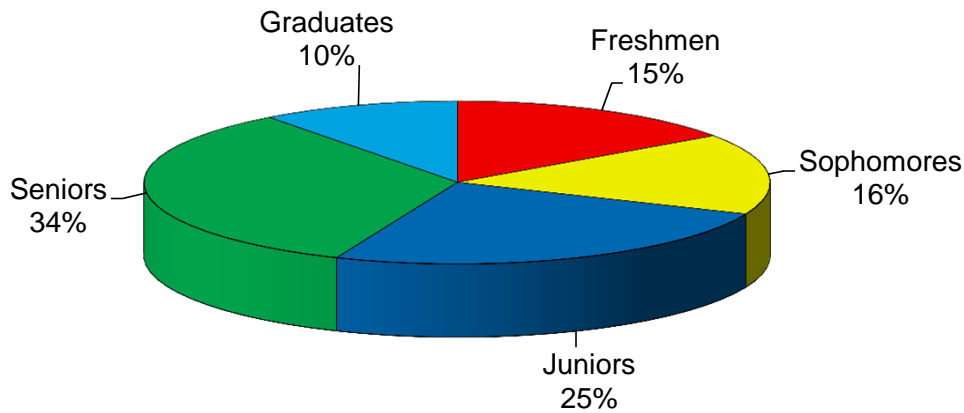

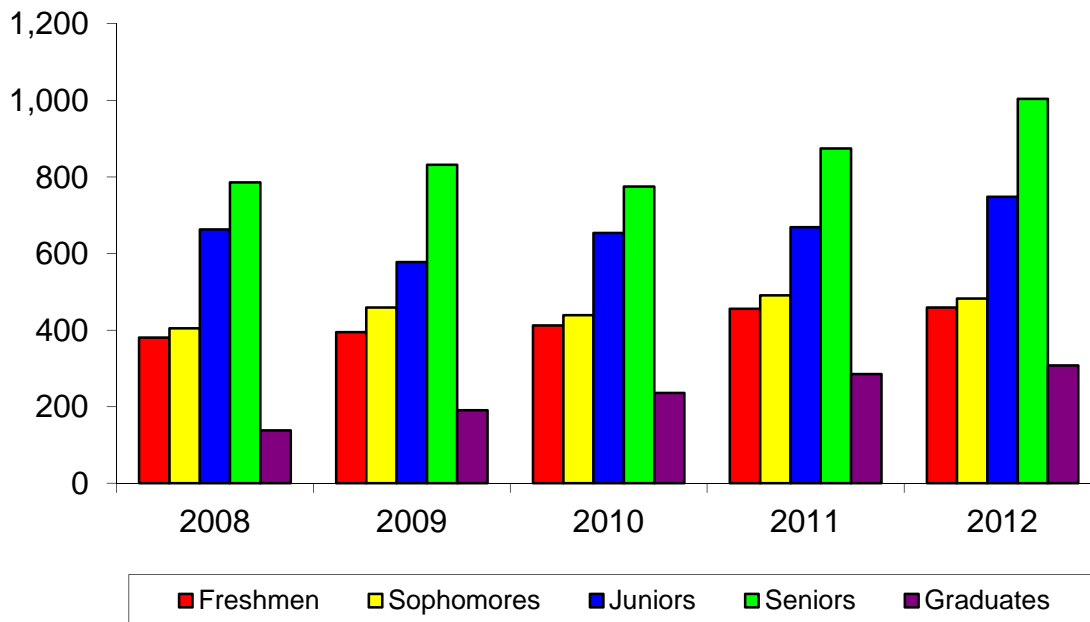
### Percentage of Total Headcount - Spring 2012

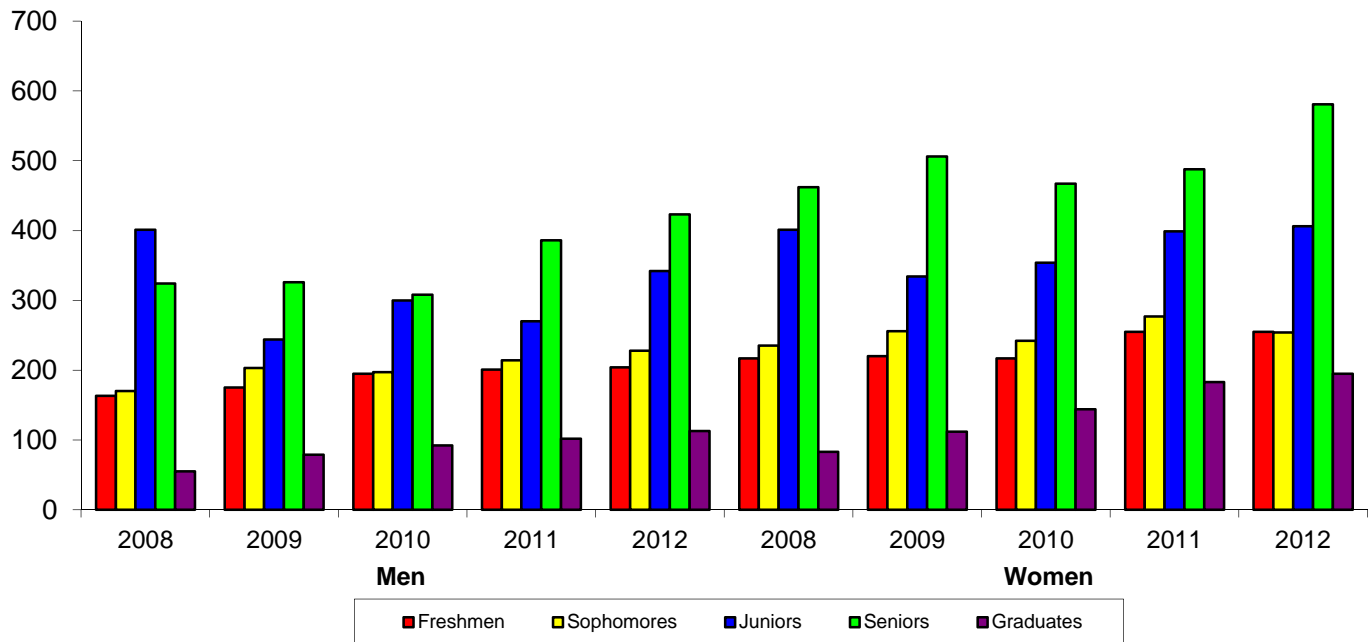

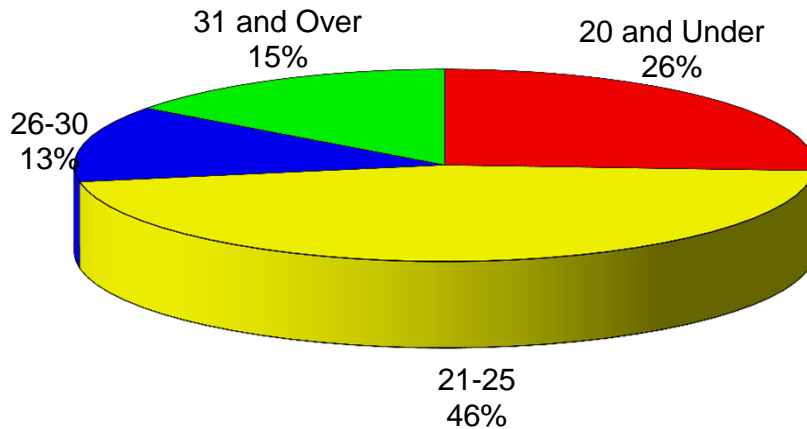

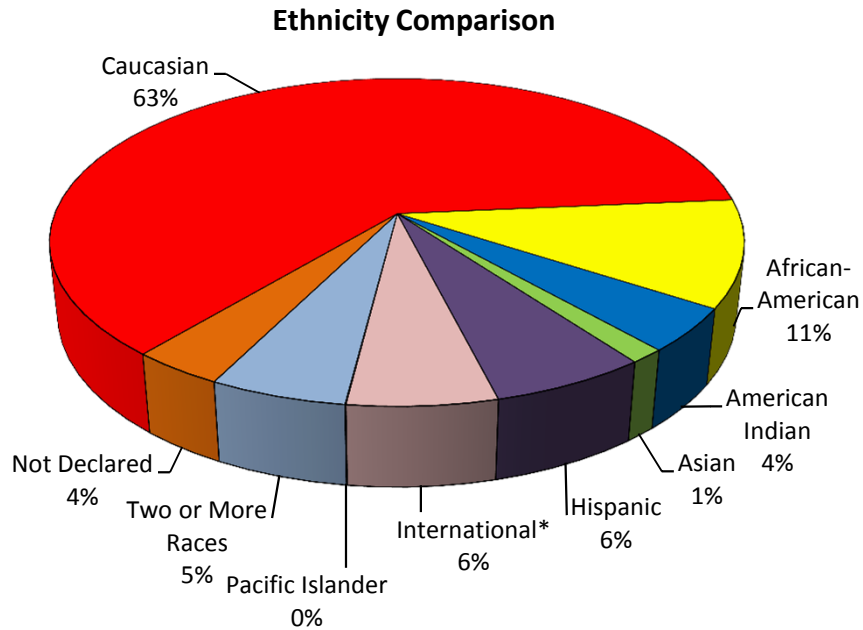
**Age Distribution - Spring 2012**

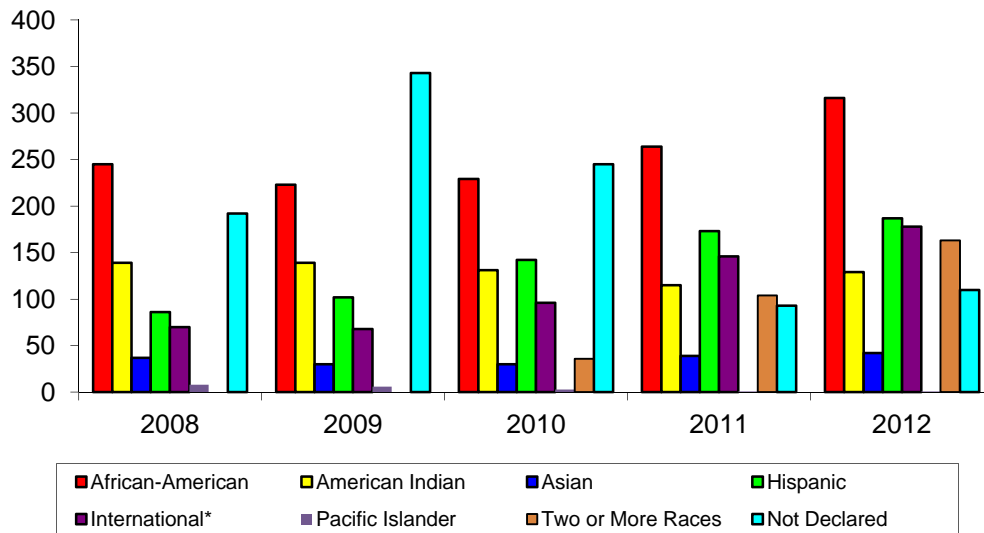

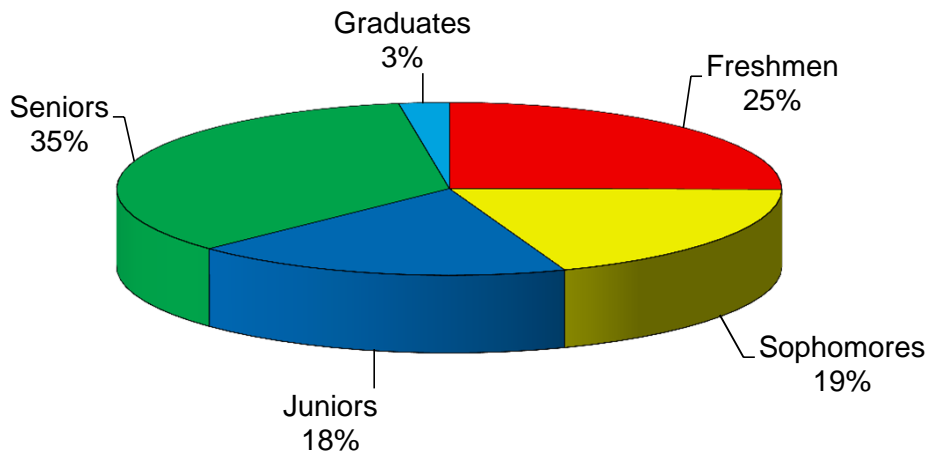

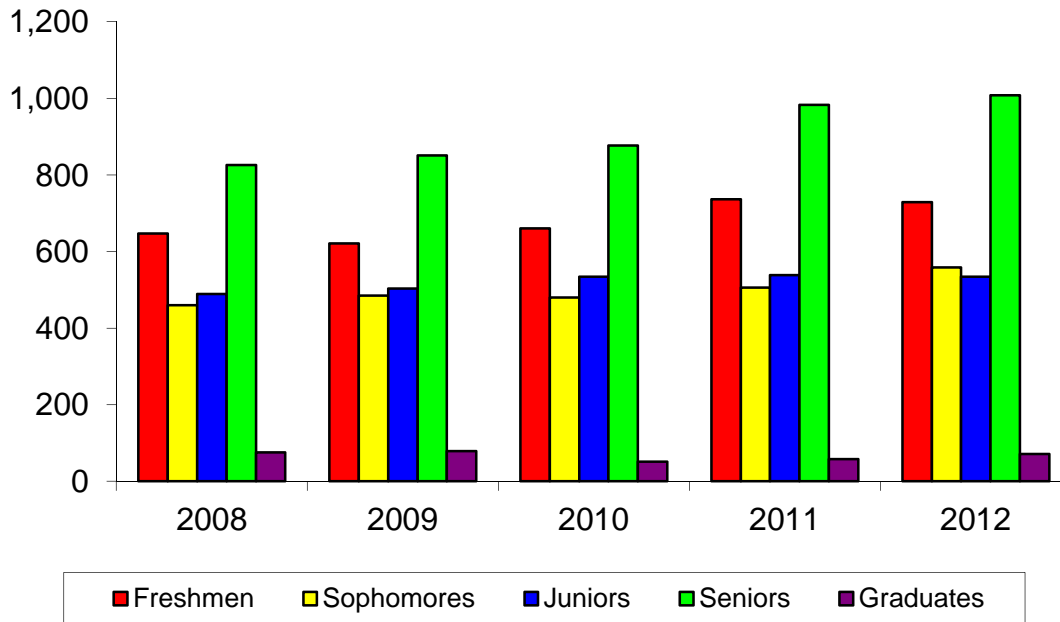
### Percentage of Total Headcount - Spring 2012

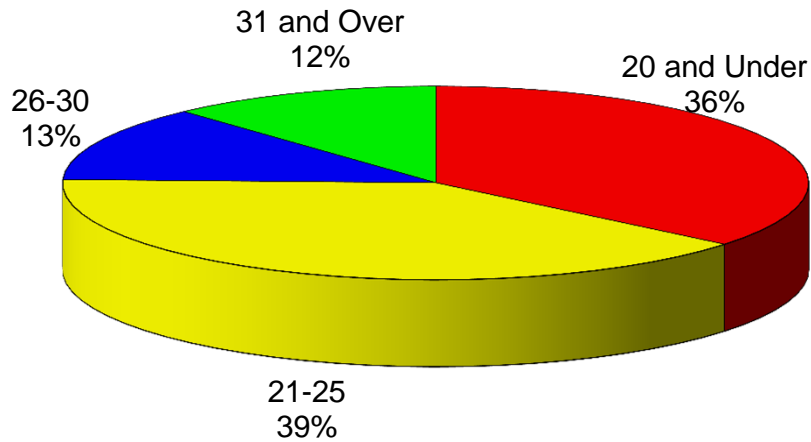

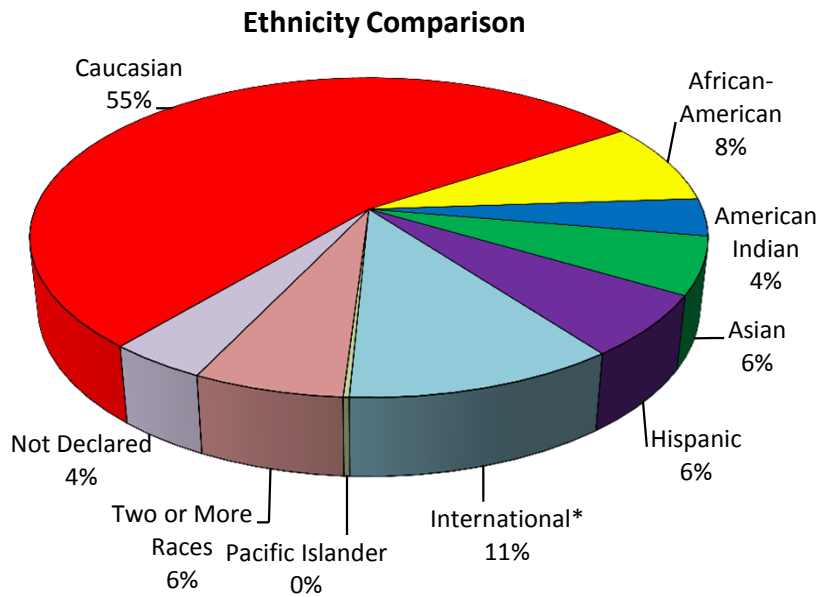
**Age Distribution - Spring 2012**

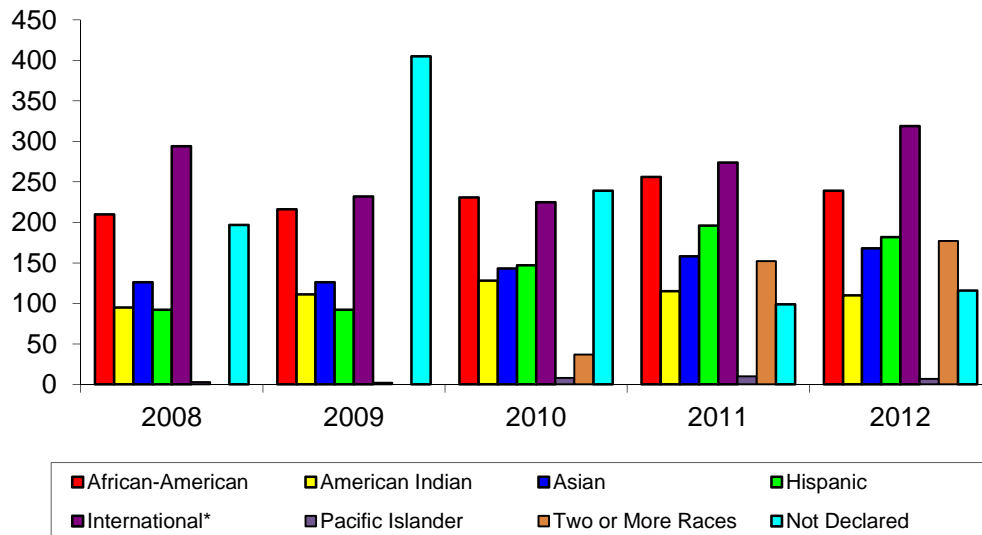

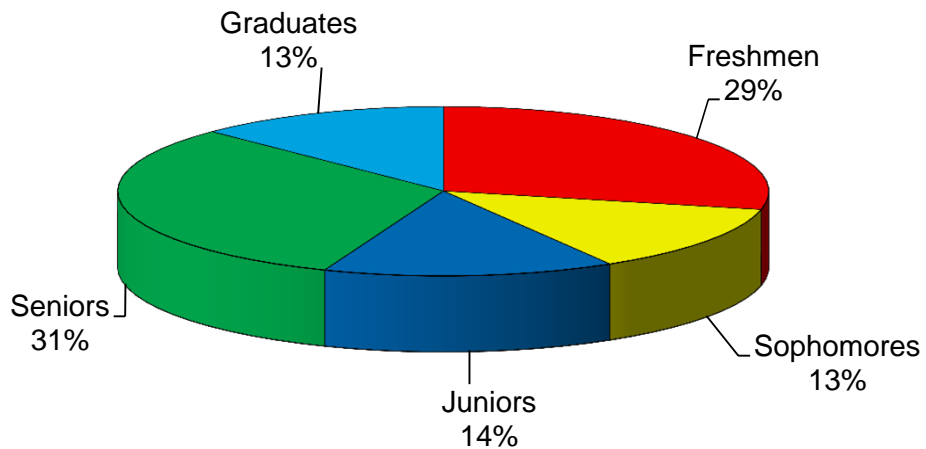

### Percentage of Total Headcount - Spring 2012

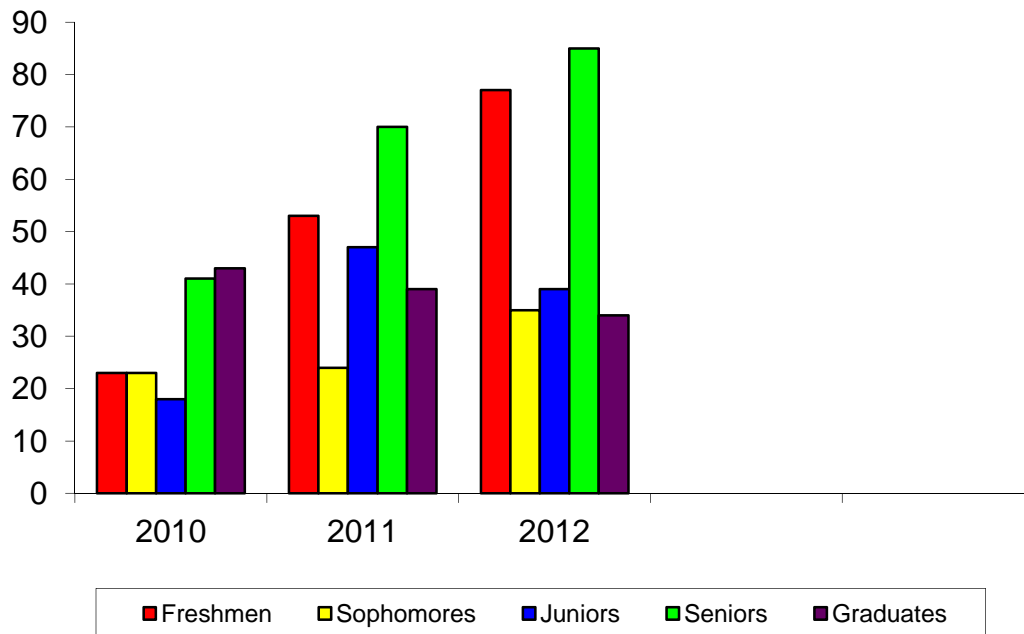

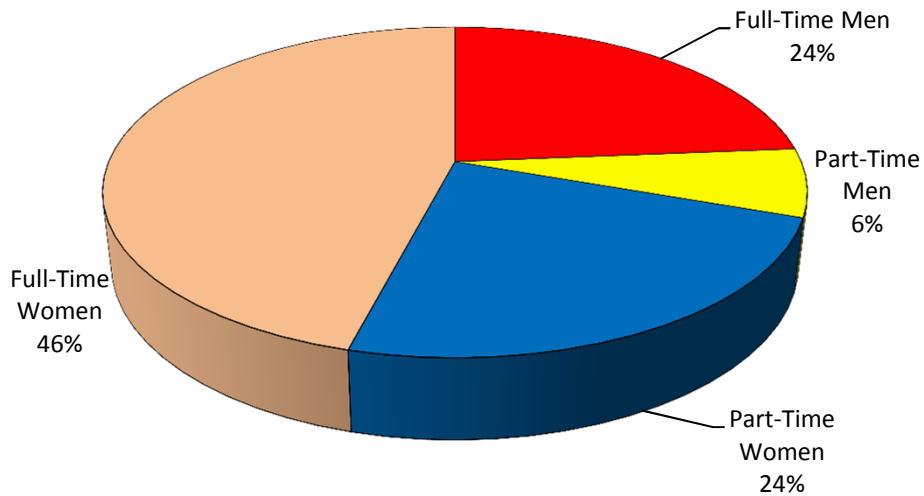

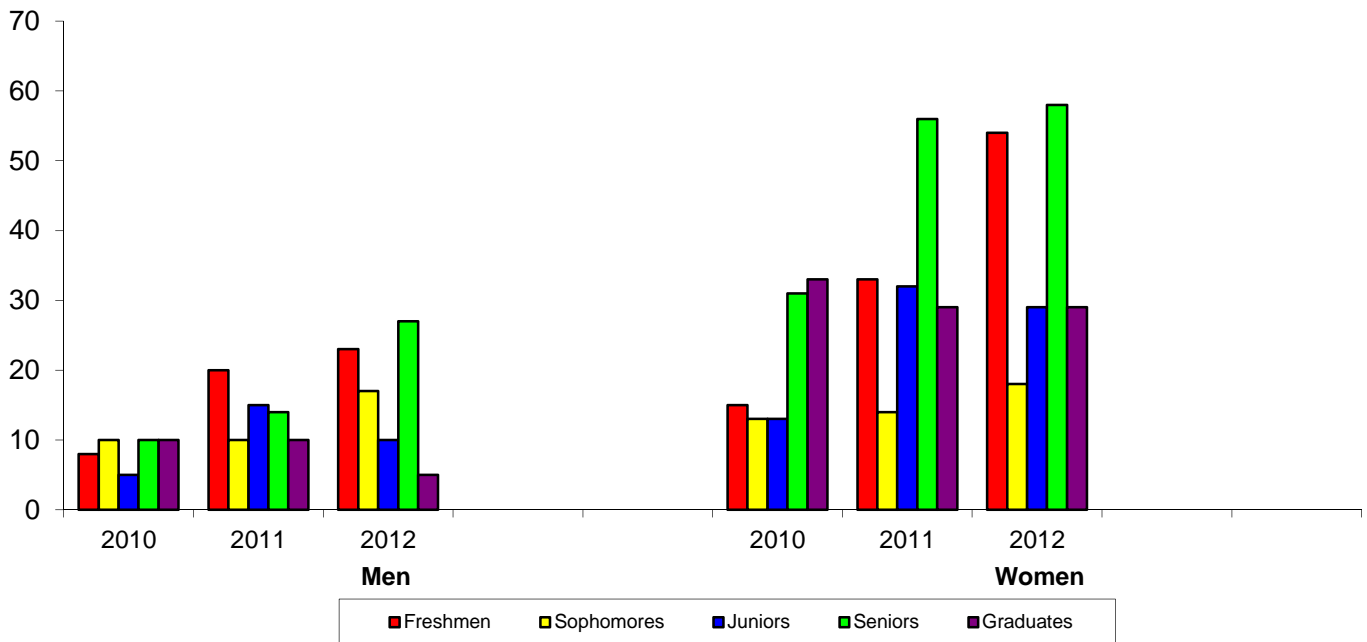
**Gender and Full/Part-Time Status**

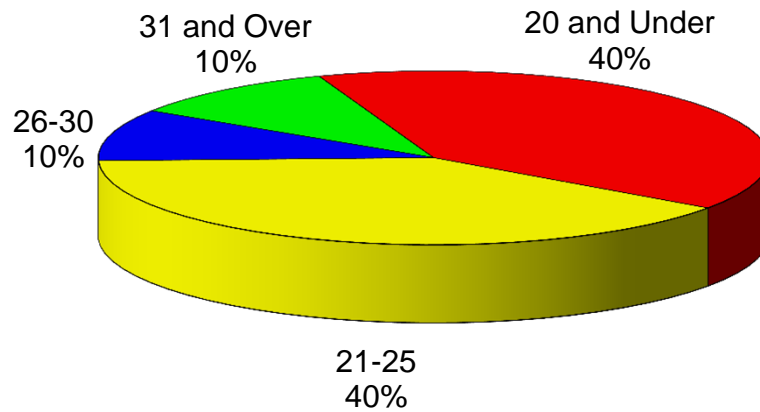

**Age Distribution - Spring 2012**

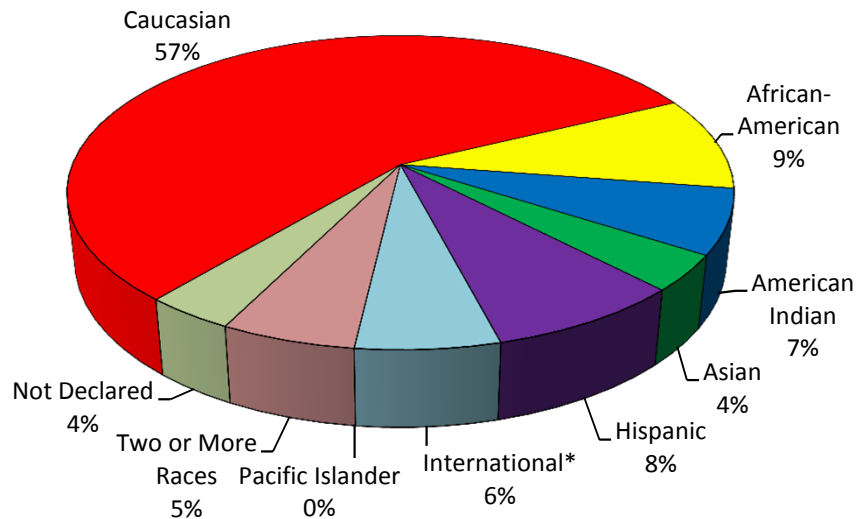

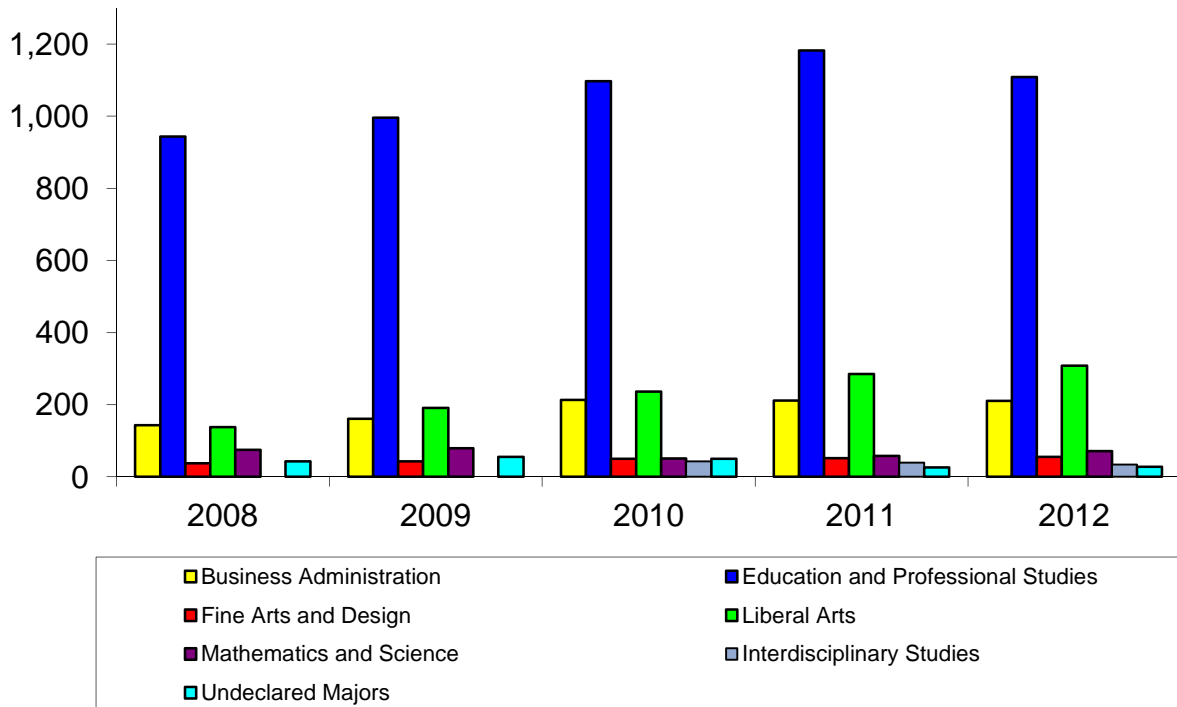
### Percentage of Total Headcount - Spring 2012

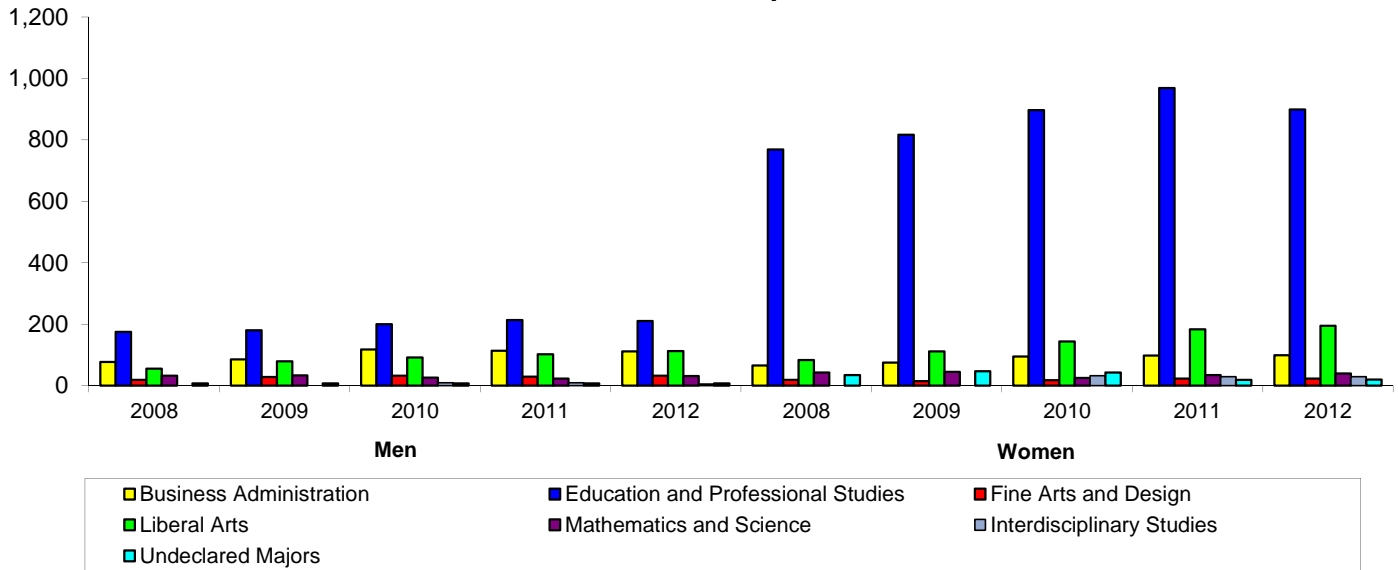

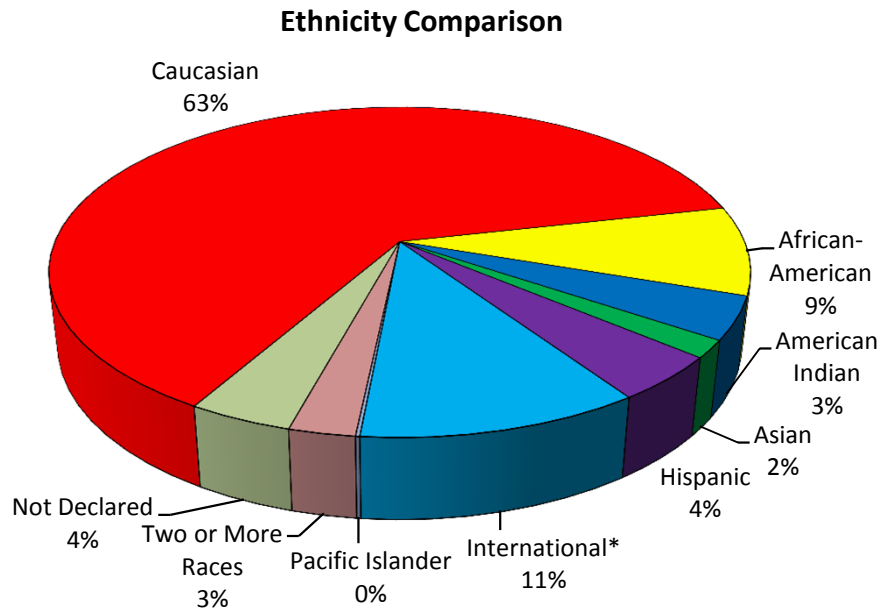
**Age Distribution - Spring 2012**

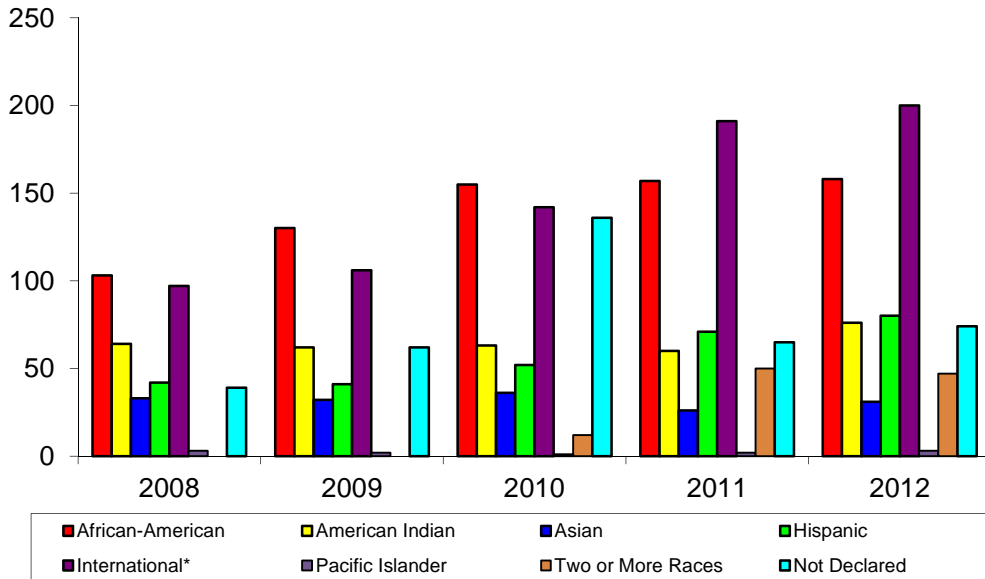

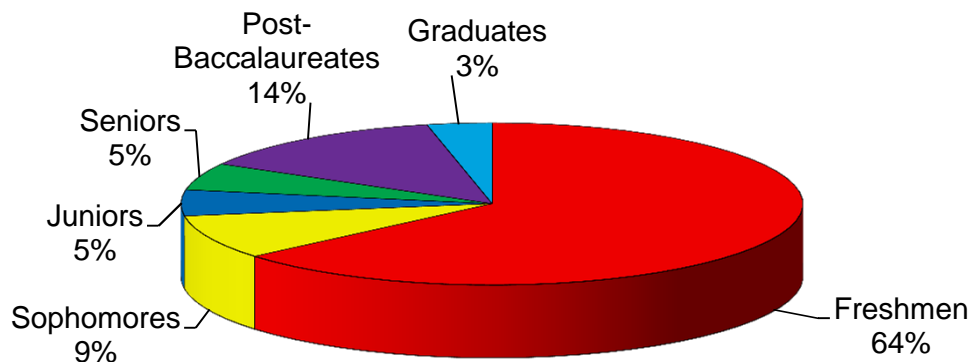

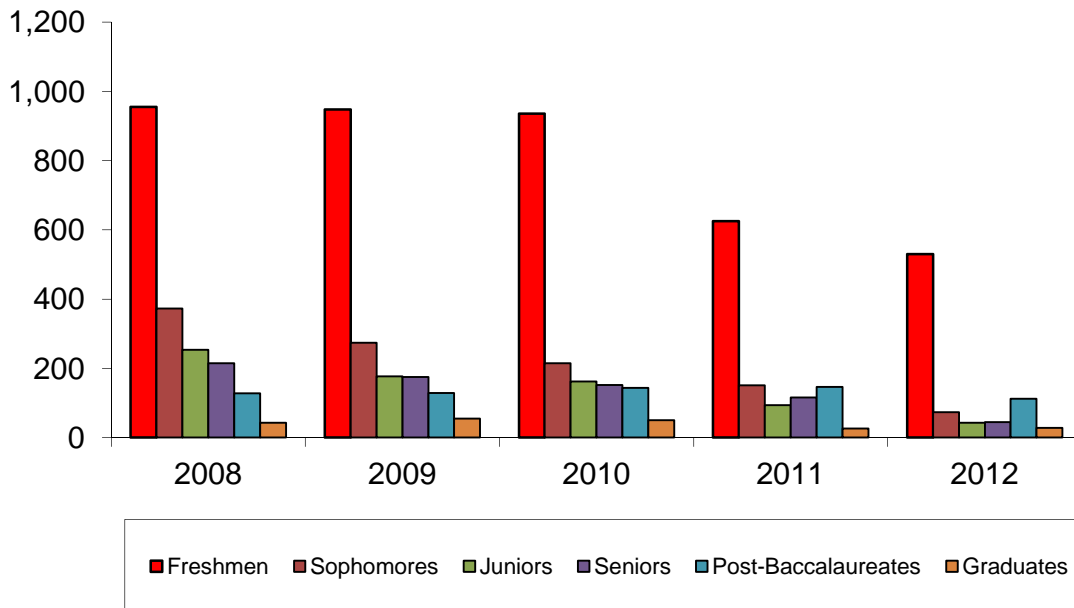
### Percentage of Total Headcount - Spring 2012

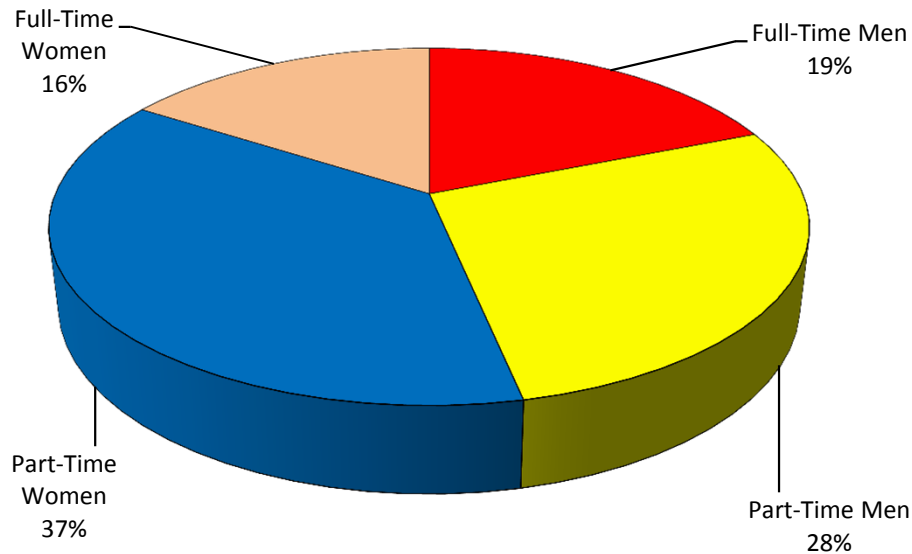

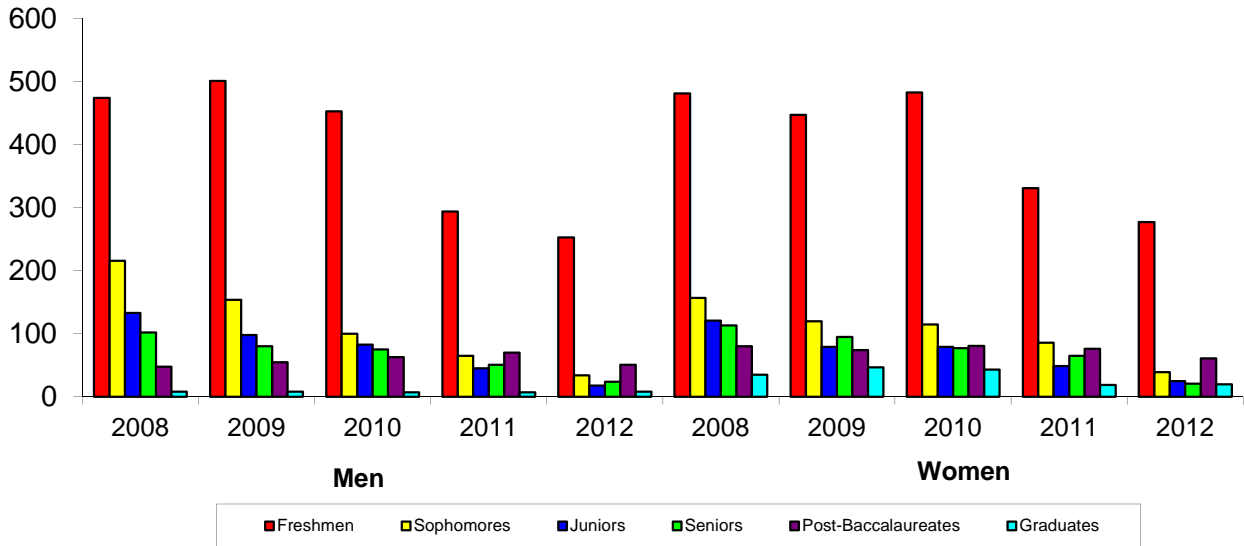
### Gender and Full/Part-Time Status

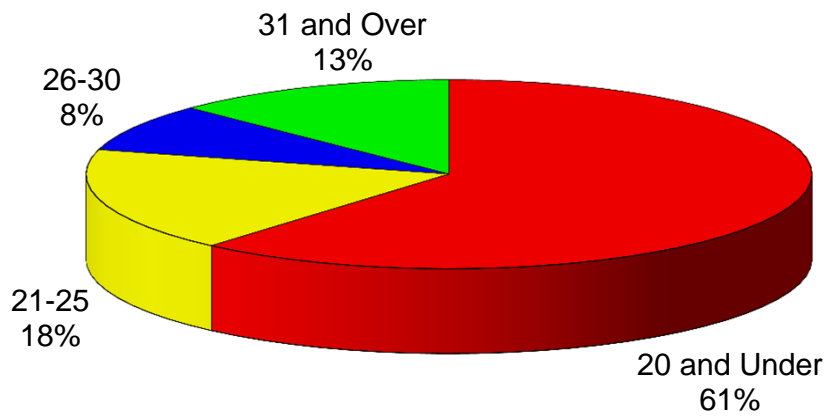

**Age Distribution - Spring 2012**

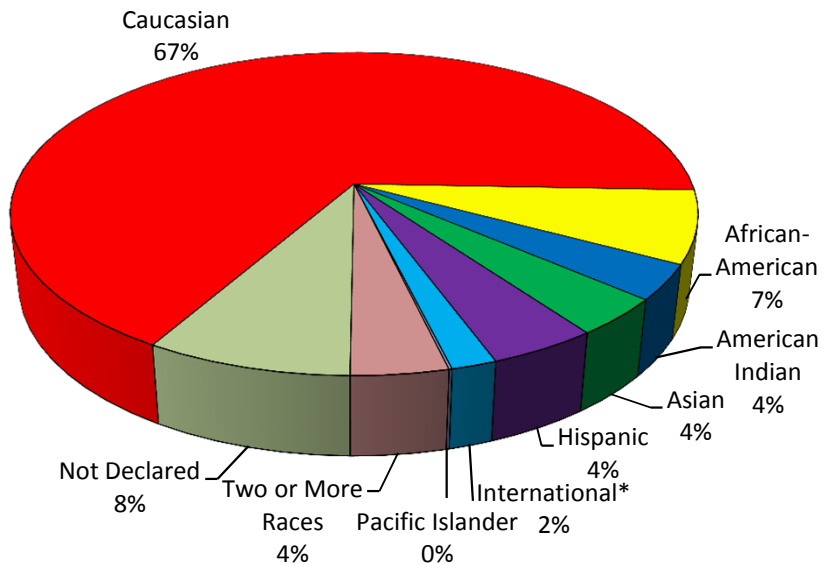
