

Exposure

The student displays a willingness to learn and grow by participating in the activity, has an awareness of their current perspectives related to the area and is starting to develop an understanding of what the area(s) entail(s).

Integration:

Transformation:

The student provides strong evidence of a learning experience that resulted in profound growth or a major shift in values, beliefs or perspectives in the tenet(s), and this may be evident through changes in behavior, speech, or ability.
