### **Publishing Discount for Frontiers Journals**

The Libraries has negotiated a 7.5% discount on article processing charges (APCs) for open access articles published by <u>Frontiers</u> for 2022. *Frontiers* journals are peer-reviewed open access publications covering a broad range of disciplines such as applied math, biomaterials, communication, digital humanities, education, ecology & evolution, earth science, environmental science, remote sensing, robotics & AI, sports & active living, sustainability, and more (see a <u>complete list</u>). The Libraries has an open access fund which offsets a portion of APC costs for <u>gold open access journals</u>; Frontiers publications are eligible for this funding.
