

# **Warning to Data Users**

Broncho Analytics provides data users with the most current institutional data available from the Office of Institutional Research. These data reflect our efforts to correct for a number of data quality issues in the student information system & provide comparable time-series data. As we have transitioned to reporting from a data warehouse, our methods have evolved. Unfortunately, this might mean a report from many years ago is no longer comparable with data reported currently on Broncho Analytics. For example, past reports on student majors were based on the student's "primary major" whereas current major reports are not limited in this way.

Data users are encouraged to consult the Office of Institutional Research when comparing data from past editions of the Factbook and Demobook to current reports on <u>Broncho Analytics</u>.

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#### INTRODUCTION

This document is intended to serve managers in their decision making processes. There has been an effort to use data that is consistent from one semester to the same semester the next year. Where possible, trend information is provided. Due to the block scheduling, which allows some classes to have a later enrollment period, the summer semester is the least consistent of the three semesters in terms of preliminary enrollment numbers.

The following bullets provide some information you may want to keep in mind while reviewing the Demographics Book:

- This is the first complete edition of the demographics book based on extracts from data warehouse. As such, it consistently reflects data captured at Midnight (i.e., the start of the day) on Official Census.
- The official census date follows the last day to drop a class, and is generally the tenth day of classes for Fall and Spring terms and generally the fifth day of classes for Summer term.
- This report is based on the concept of **Distinct Student**. It provides for consistent headcount reporting of students with multiple majors. This allows students to be counted for each declared major, which may span departments and/or colleges. For example, a student would appear in two departments (one for each major) but only once in the college and university if they have double-majored in one college. A student would appear in two departments and colleges (one for each major) but only once in the university if they have double-majored in two colleges.
- Student credit hours are sorted two ways: by student classification (for FTE calculations) or by course level (for production by department).
- Students are not associated with a college until they declare a major. There is a section of reports to show the statistics for those students with an undeclared major.
- There is a report to track students on campus by time of day. Students may be counted in more than one category or college.





#### **Headcount by Full/Part Time Status by Gender**



#### **Enrollment Trends by Gender & Class**








#### Ethnicity/Race, Fall 2017











### **Enrollment Trends by Gender & Class**







### Headcount by Full/Part Time Status by Gender





































#### **Enrollment Trends by Gender & Class**


















#### Ethnicity/Race, Fall 2017

#### Headcount by Ethnicity/Race by Term







#### **Enrollment Trends by Gender & College**















#### **Enrollment Trends by Gender & Class**






