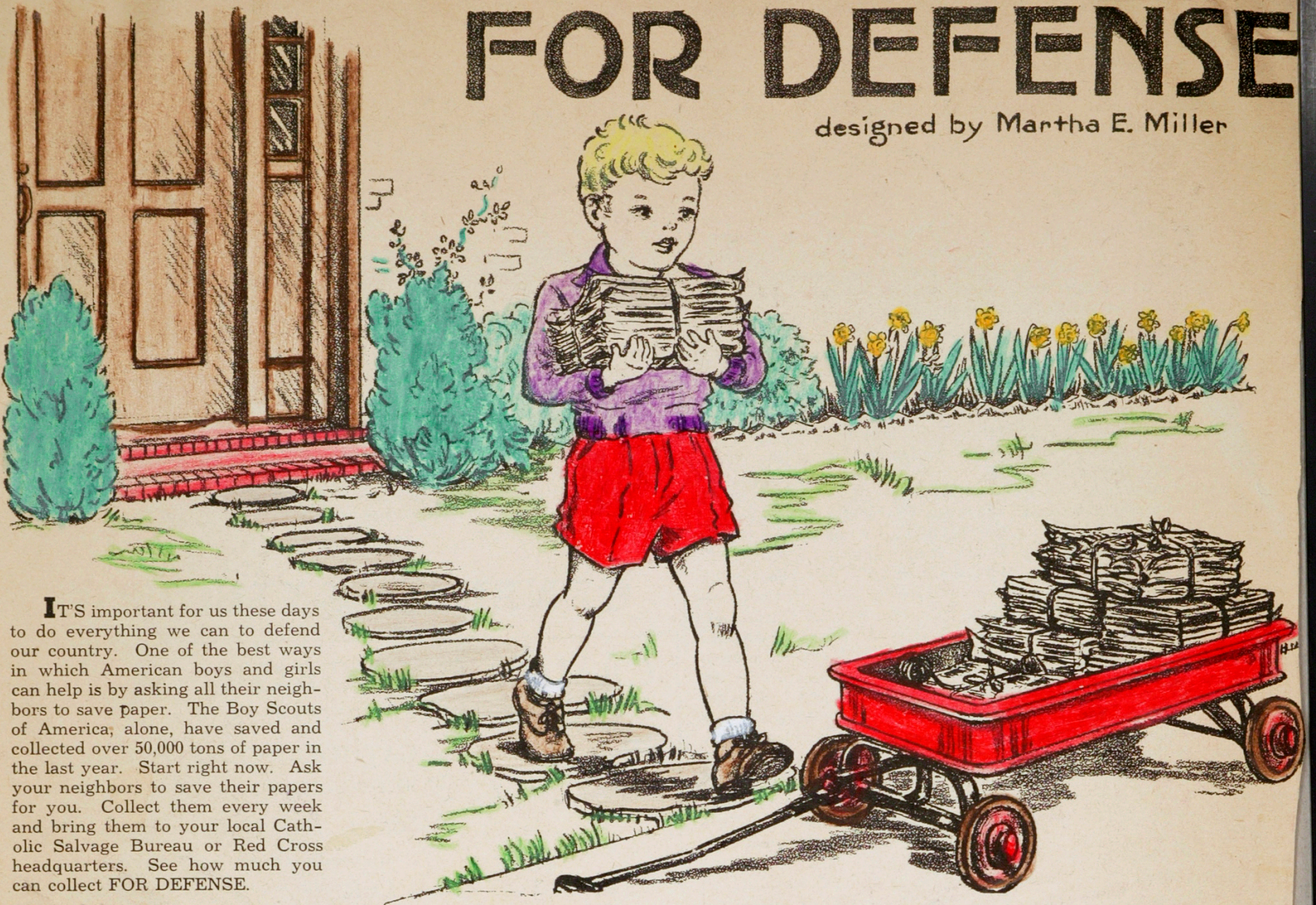


This picture, we found in the newspaper, gives an idea of how our classrom looks. We also knit for our boys in service.

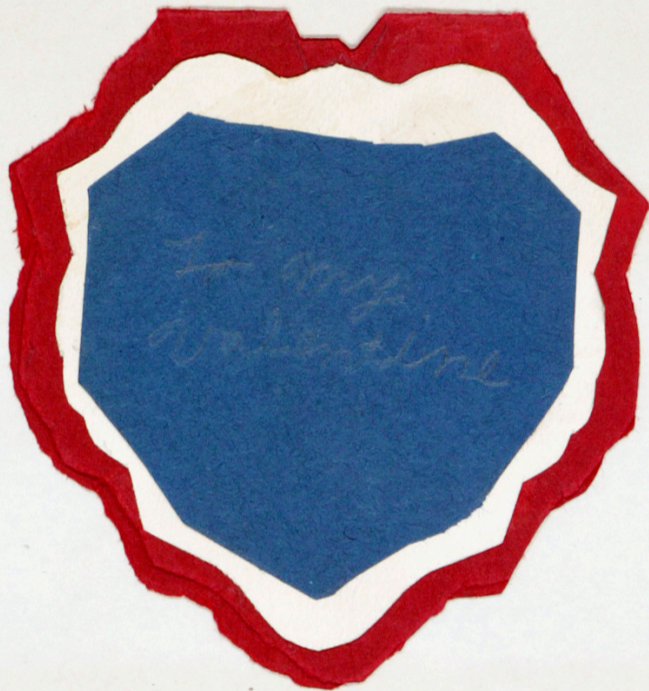


"WAR BONDS"
