### SAVE

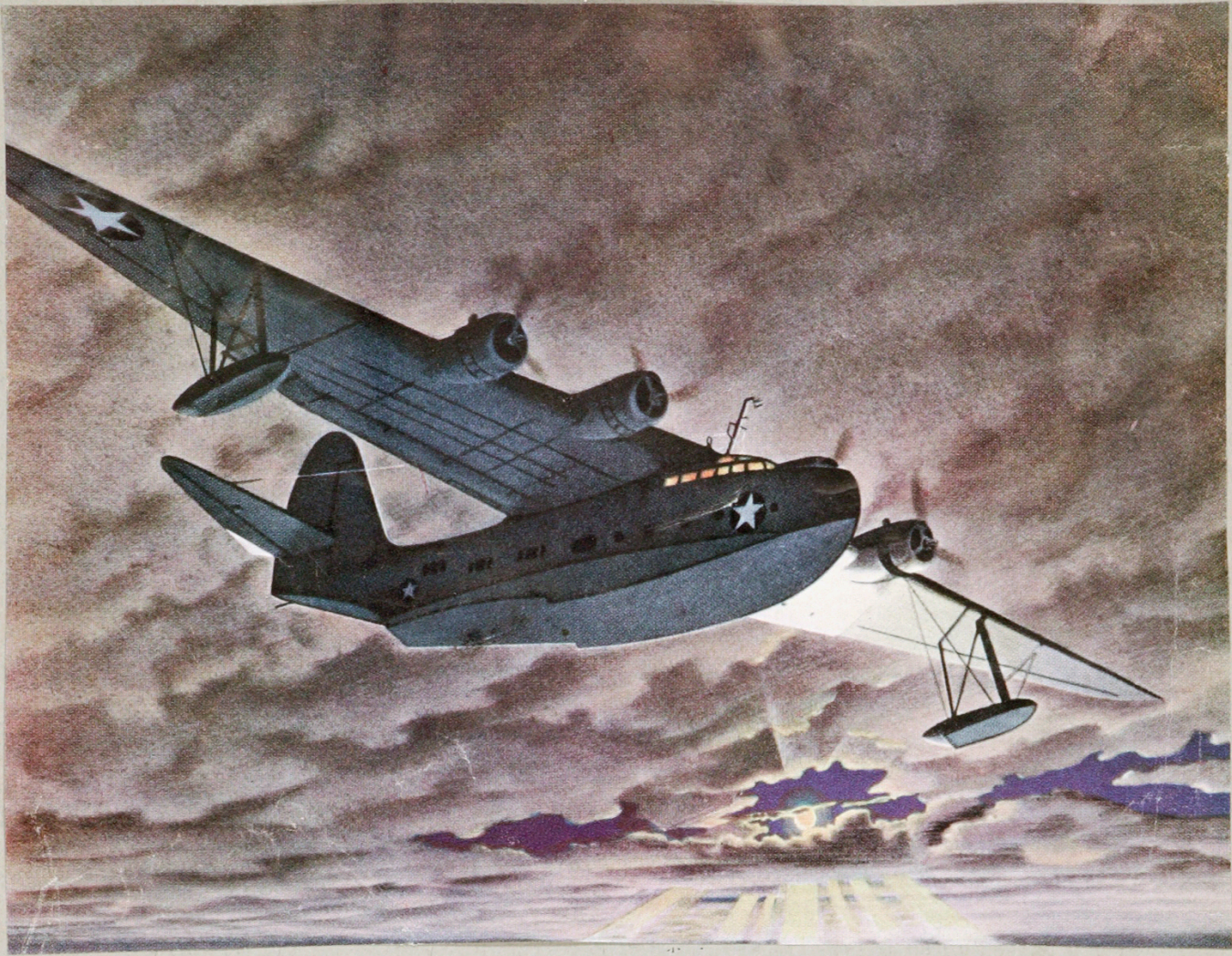
We save by taking care of our clothes, shoes, & by not driving our cars too much, by buying bonds and stamps and by saving food.

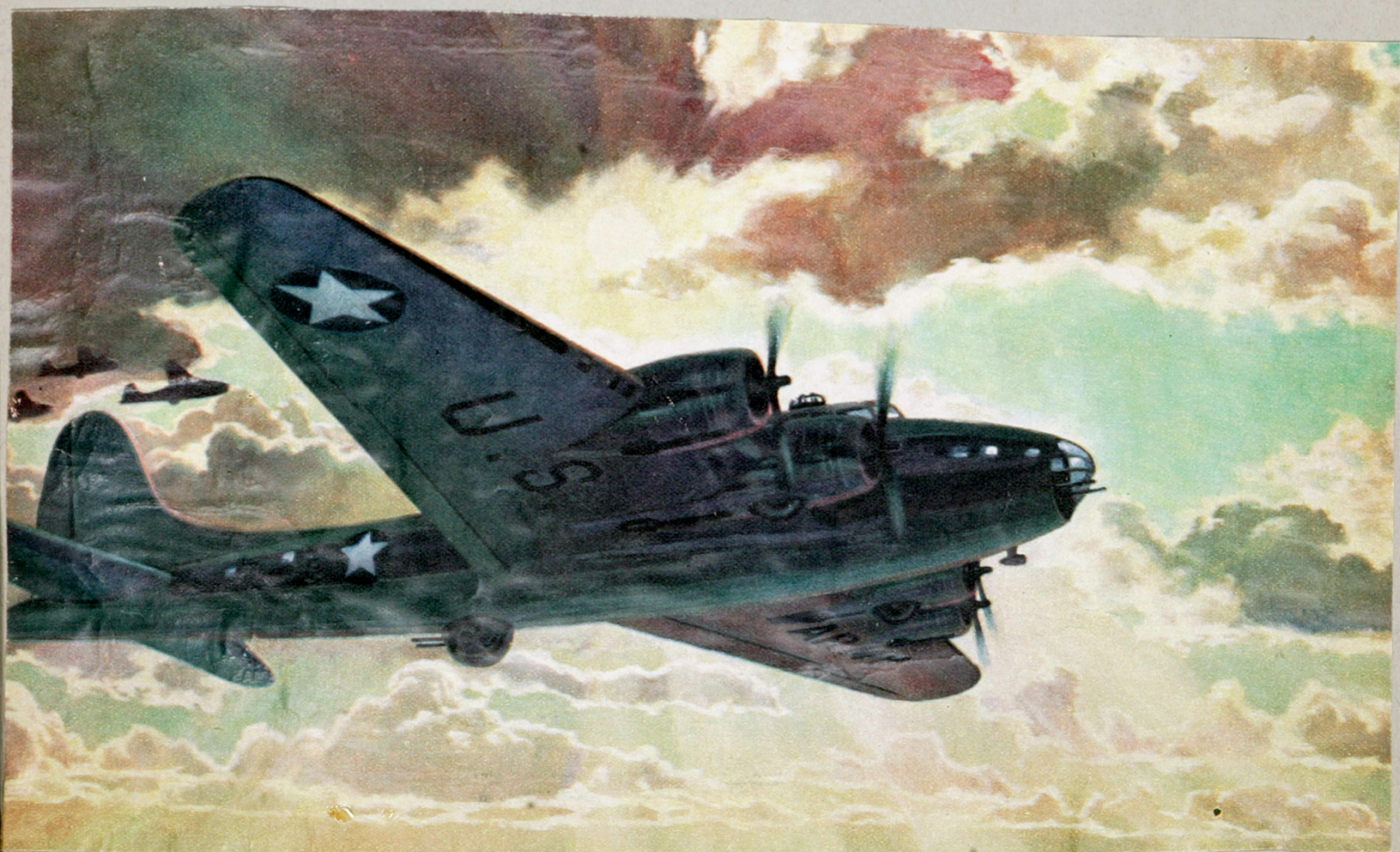
