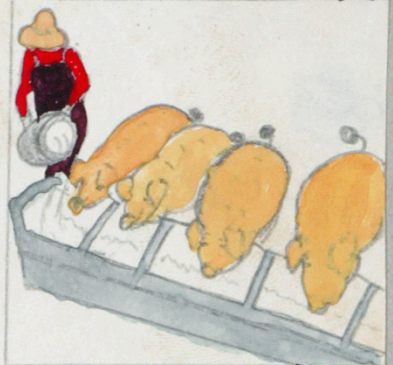

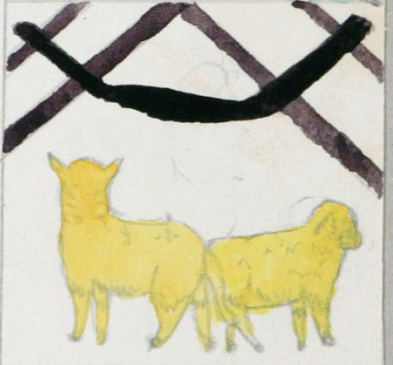

A program was given impersonating characters and those who could not guess and also those who entered had to pay a stamp.

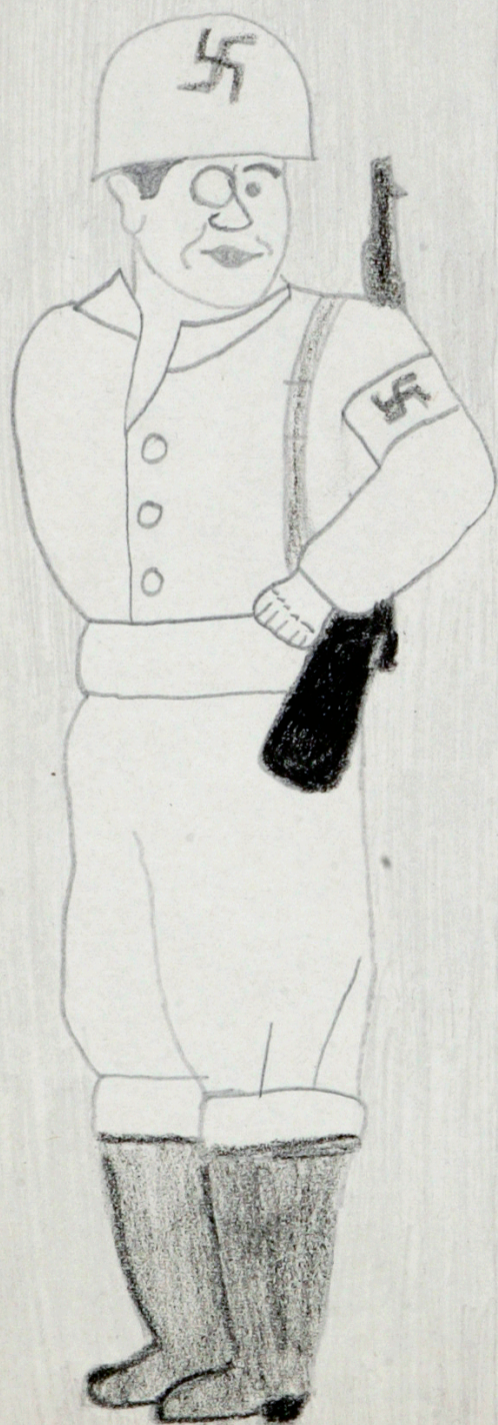
Each child is encouraged weekly to buy stamps and discontinue picture shows every week.
