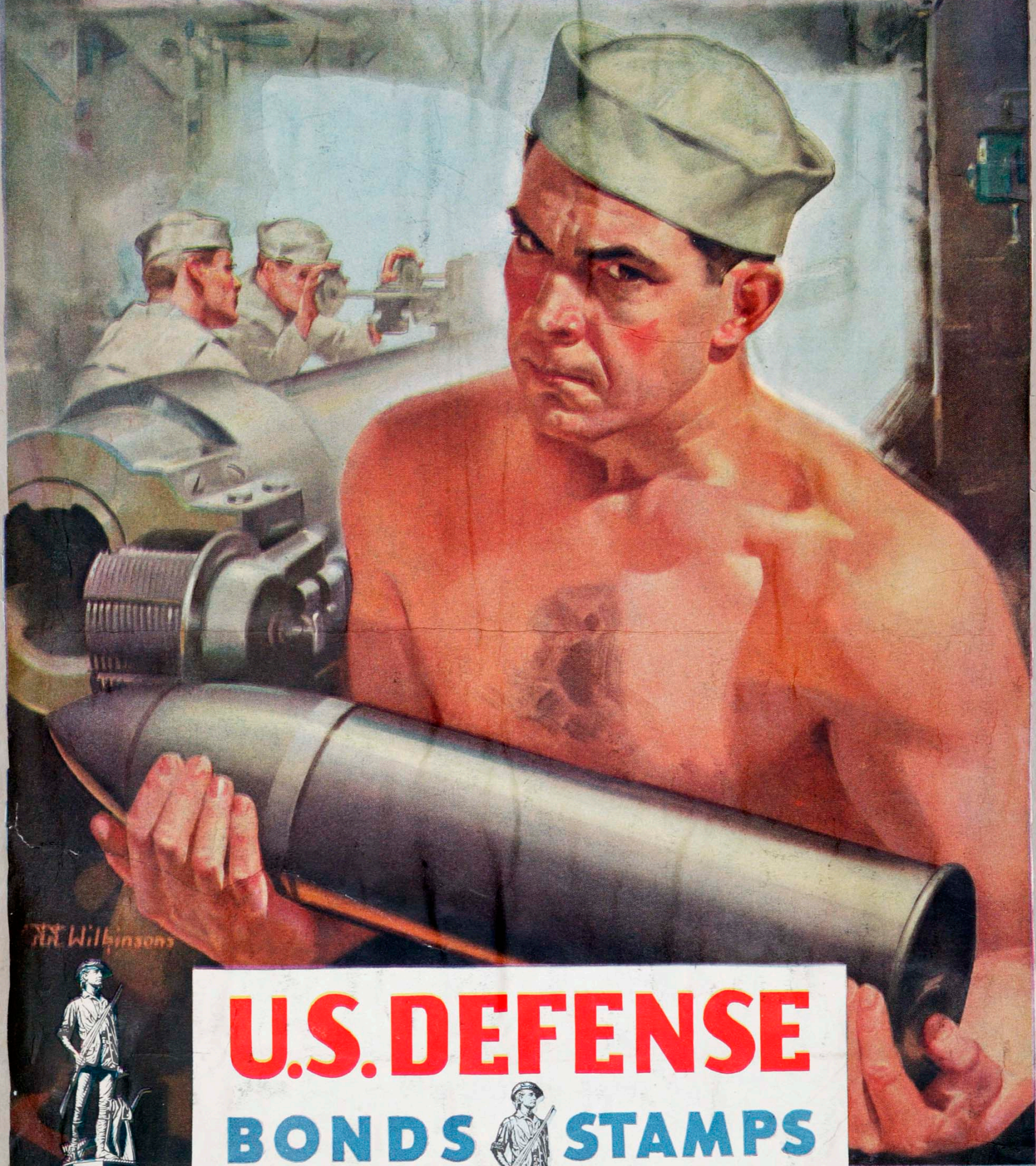

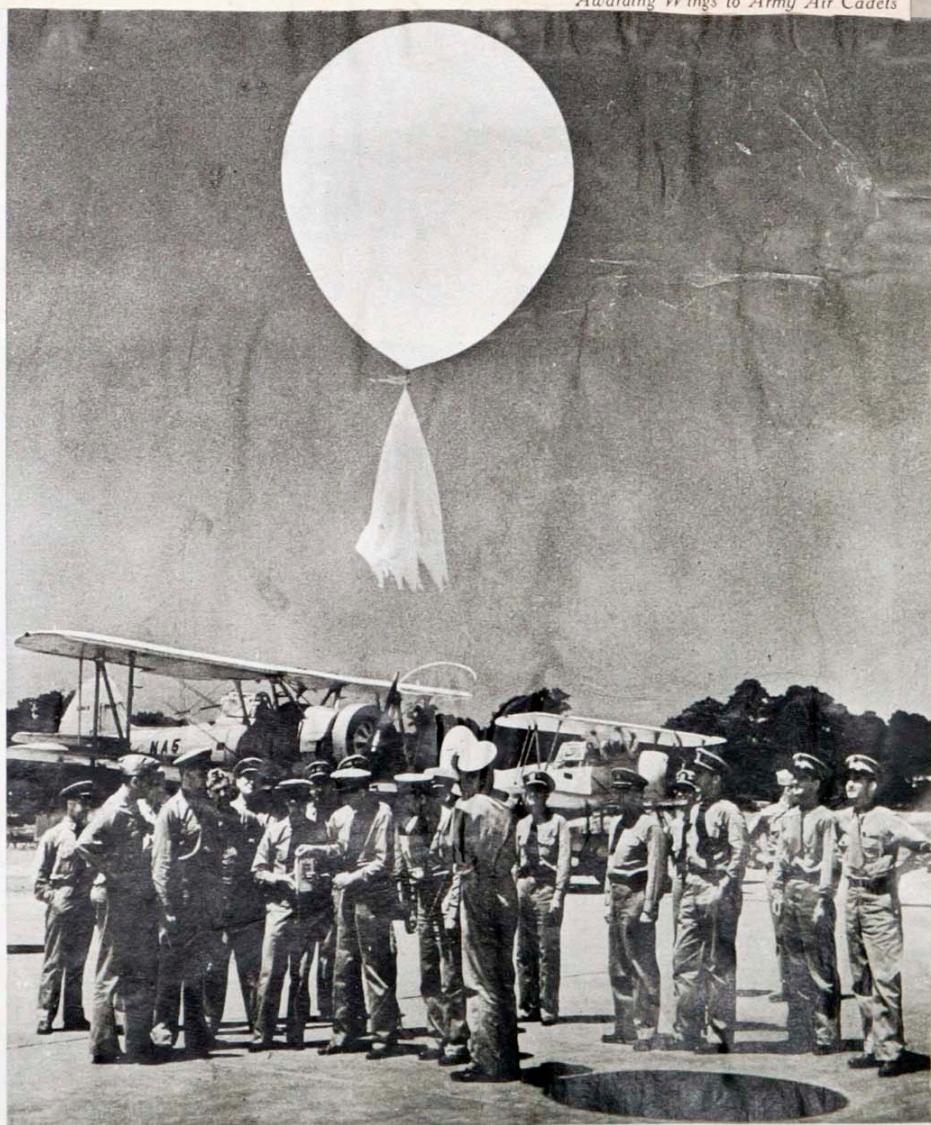




*Awarding Wings to Army Air Cadets*
