| Greens | At least twice a week | Can at least 50 quarts to last six months |
| Tomatoes | At least twice a week | Can at least 72 quarts to last nine months |
| Asparagus <br> Beets <br> Carrots <br> Corn <br> Beans (string) <br> Okra <br> Squash <br> Soup mixture | At least three times a week <br> (Select from group) |  |
