STATISTICAL SUMMARY OF 4-H CLUB WORK  
(With Special Emphasis on 1954)

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Since the passage of the Smith-Lever Act in 1914, a total of 17,645,713 boys and girls have participated in 4-H Club work. The enrollment in 1914, including any renewals from club work organized previously, was 116,262. Except for three short periods, one during the First World War, one during the depression, and the third during the Second World War, the number of boys and girls enrolled each year has increased. The 1954 enrollment reached an all time high of 2,104,787 (p. 2). Forty-five percent of these members were boys and 55 percent were girls. The percentage of boys and girls who satisfactorily completed their club work in 1954 was 79.8 percent (p. 3).

Of the 2,104,787 4-H Club members in 1954, 1,395,110 or 66 percent came from farm homes, 435,966 or 21 percent came from rural nonfarm homes, and 273,711 or 13 percent came from urban homes (p. 4).

In 1954, 28 percent of the 4,900,000 farm boys and girls in the 48 States, according to the 1950 Census, were enrolled in 4-H Club work. Eight percent of the 5,400,000 rural nonfarm boys and girls and two percent of the 13,600,000 urban boys and girls were also enrolled (p. 4). As the Census data are now 4 years old, there may be some slight change in various States in the percentage of youth available for 4-H Club work.

Most 4-H'ers join at the age of 10 or under. The average age of the boys is 12.7 years and the girls 12.5 years. Of the total boys enrolled 53 percent were 12 years old or under, 35 percent were 13 to 15 years old, and 12 percent were 16 years old or over. The girls average slightly younger than the boys, with 57 percent under 12 years of age, 33 percent 13 to 15 years old, and 10 percent 16 years old and over (pp. 5, 6).

The average number of years boys and girls remain in 4-H Club work is 2.7 years. Thirty-three percent of the boys and girls enrolled in 1954 were first year members, 23 percent were second year members, 28 percent had been members 3 or 4 years and 16 percent from 5 to 10 years (pp. 5, 8). The percentage of reenrollment in 4-H Club work was 68.3 percent in 1954 (p. 10).

The clothing project continued to have the greatest percentage of total enrollment in 1954, with meal planning and preparation, and vegetable growing holding second and third places (pp. 11-16).

In 1954 there were 88,093 organized 4-H Clubs in the United States, Alaska, Hawaii, and Puerto Rico, more than twice as many as were reported in 1925, which was the first year our reports showed the number of 4-H Clubs. The average number of members per club has increased from 14 in 1925 to 26 in 1954 (p. 19).

The use and training of voluntary local leaders in 1954 increased over that of 1953. The number of leaders increased 9 percent (p. 21). Each local leader attended an average of 5.6 leader-training meetings. They, in turn, held an average of 8 meetings per club which were not attended by the county extension agents. In addition the county extension agents held an average of 6 meetings per club, which in most instances were also attended by the local leaders (p. 23).

The years of county extension agents' time devoted to 4-H Club work in 1954 increased 2 percent over the time devoted in 1953.

"Years of county extension agents' time devoted to 4-H Club work is a calculated figure. It is obtained by dividing the number of days devoted to 4-H Club work reported by all county extension agents in the State or region concerned by 280, which is an average number of working days in a year. This has been done in order to compare States having county 4-H Club agents with those where agricultural and home demonstration agents devote part time to 4-H Club work (p. 25)."

The Extension program for young men and women is directed to those young people approximately 18 to 30 years of age, whose interests and needs have matured beyond the 4-H Club program, but who have not been effectively absorbed into adult work. A total of 290,889 young people were reached through special programs in 1954 (p. 26).

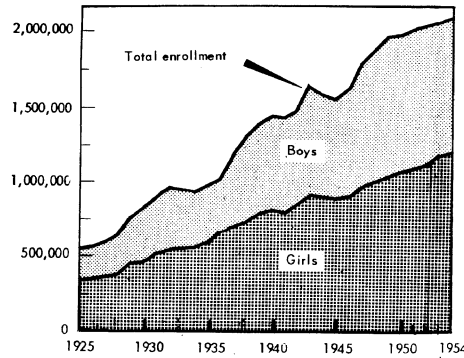

The average age of 4-H Club members is calculated by multiplying the members who are 10 years old and under by 10; 11 years old by 11; 12 years old by 12; 13 years old by 13; 14 years old by 14; 15 years old by 15; 16 years old by 16, and those who are 17 years old and over by the factor 17.7. The results are added and divided by the total number of members enrolled to find the average age of 4-H Club members.

Since the average age of the members at the time of enrollment in 1954 was 12.6 years and the average number of years the members had been in club work was 2.7 years (Table 5), their average age at which they enrolled for the first time in 4-H Club work was 9.9 years (12.6- 2.7). Table 5 gives the average length of membership from 1930 to 1954.

There is no appreciable difference between the average age of boys and girls or in the age at which each first joined 4-H Club work.

The average length of membership in years is calculated by multiplying the members who are in club work 1 year by 1; those who continue for two years by 2; 3 years by 3; 4 years by 4; 5 years by 5; and those who continue 6 years and over by the factor 6.9. The results are added and divided by the total number of 4-H Club members enrolled, to find the average length of membership in years. The average length of membership of both boys and girls was 2.7 years in 1954, which figure has remained constant since 1951.

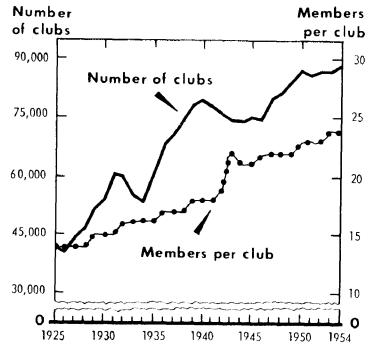

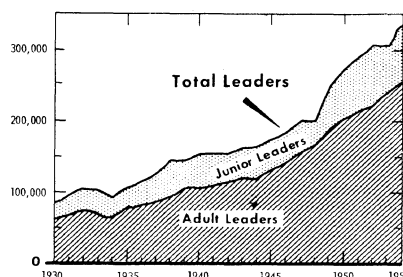

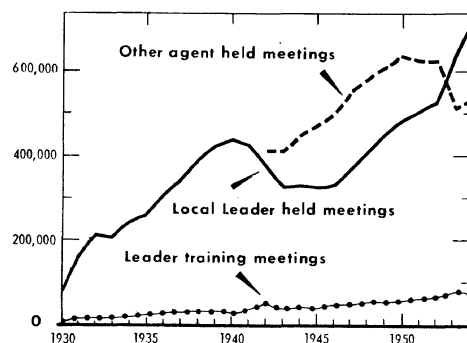
