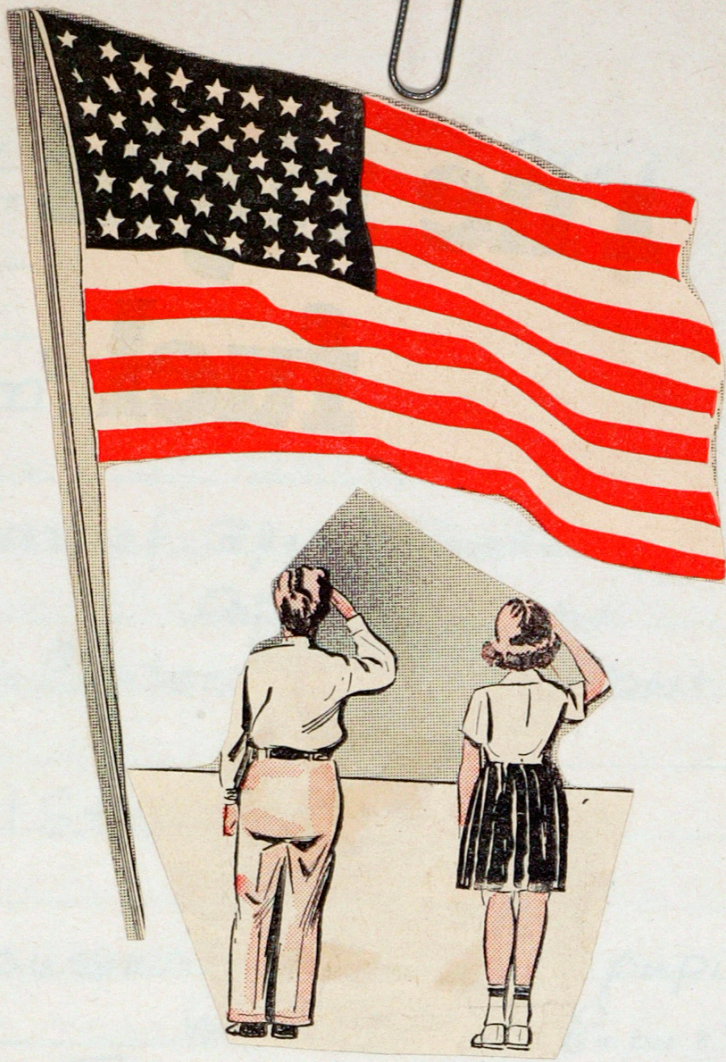

As song birds on the wing.

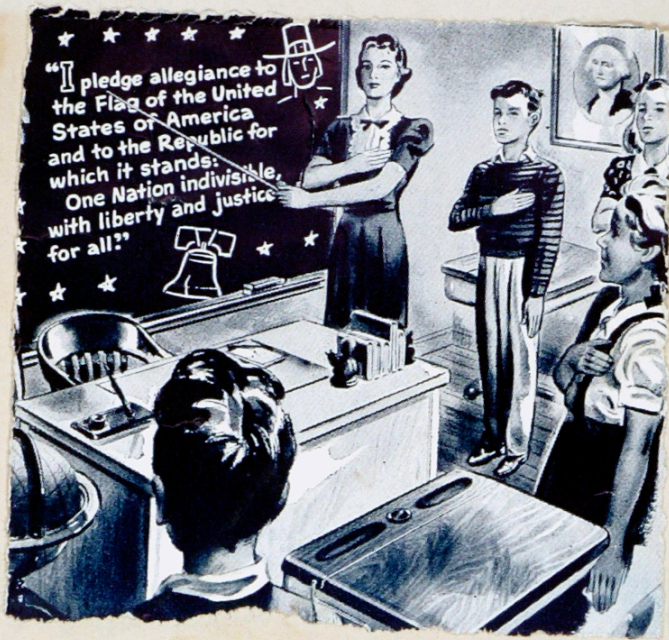

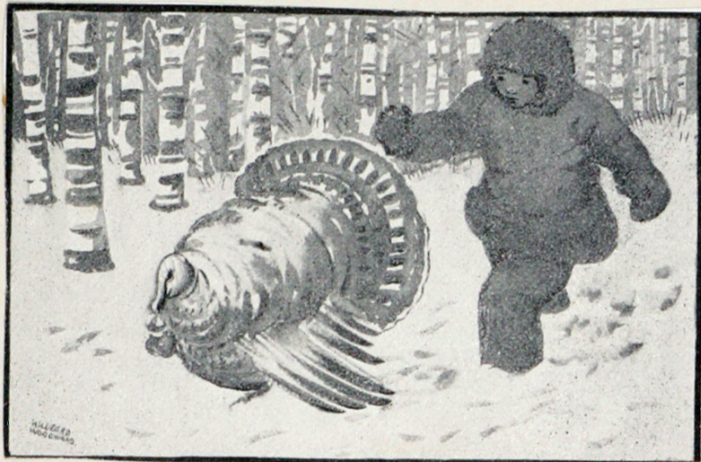
