West Point School Wins "Scrap" Prize

West Point district school, Miss Ann Smith, teacher has been awarded a \$25.00 war bond prize in the Oklahoma newspapers' \$4,000 scrap metal contest and are to be commended for their efforts. The school contributed 19,405 pounds of scrap metal in drive with an average of 425 pounds per pupil.

With the assistance of their good teacher and the girls of the school the following boys made a thorough canvas of the district to win the coveted honor: Dick [unclear], Marvin Stejskal and Bernard [unclear].



YOU HEAR: Prize of a \$25 war bond for having the largest per capita amount of scrap of any school in the county in the recent Newspaper Scrap Metal drive was announced by the state managers of the drive for West Point school. The school, taught by Miss. Anne Smith had 2,425.62 pounds per capita. It was 18th in the state in point of per capita poundage.

Fairview school, taught by Mrs. Hilda Nice, will receive the award of \$10 in war stamps and Calumet consolidated school the \$25 war bond offered by the county Scrap committee.

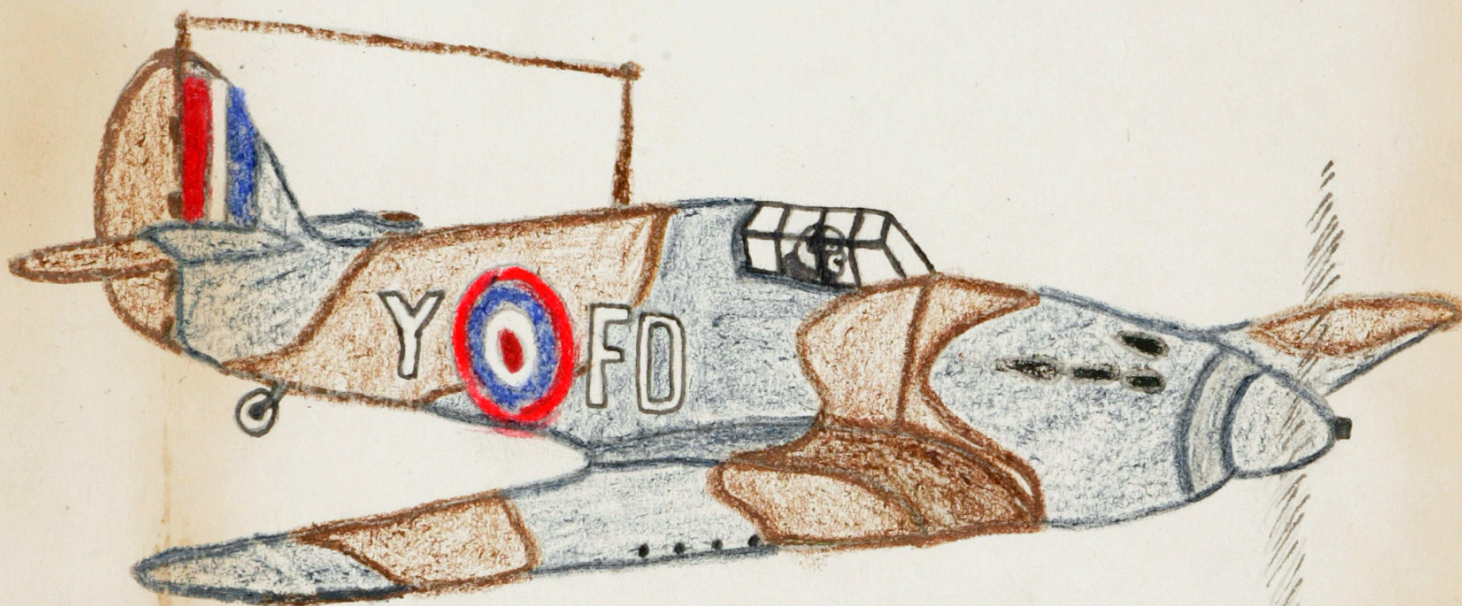

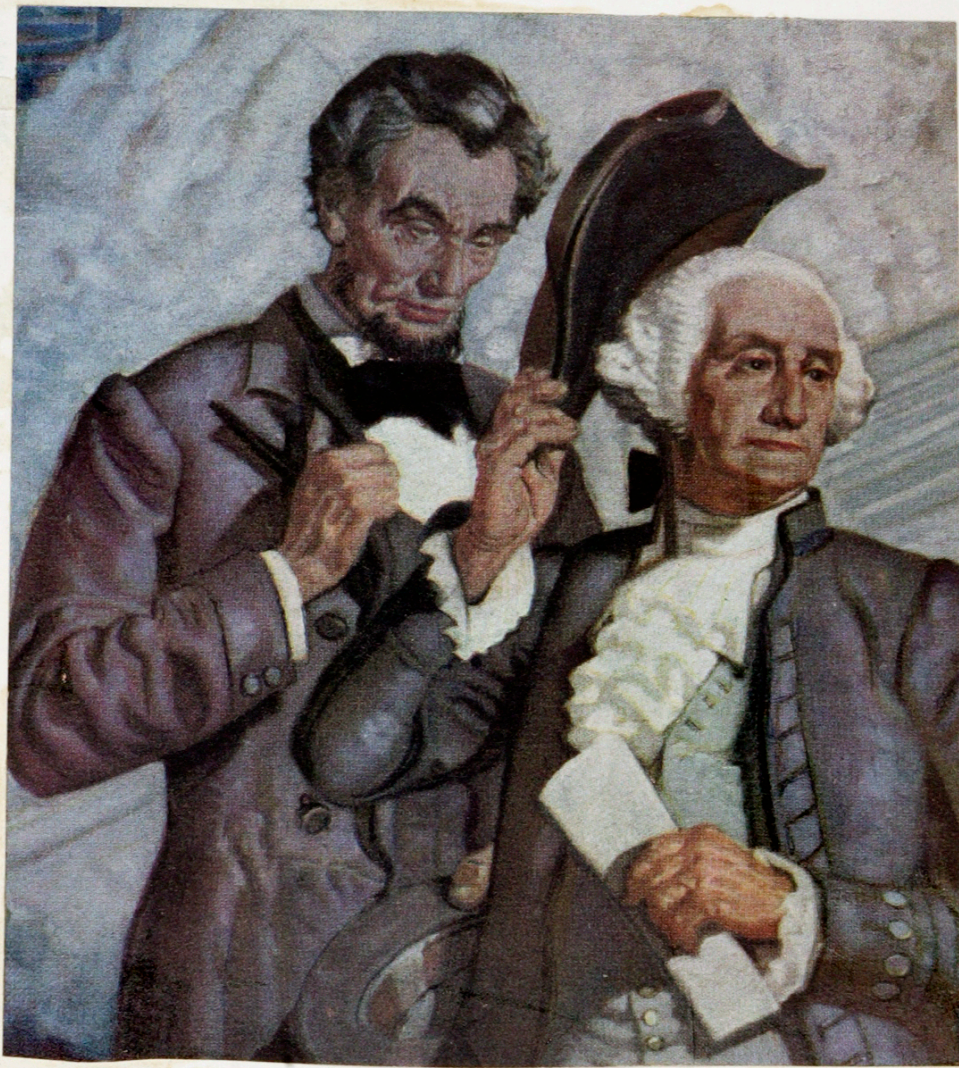
