There were 106 comments with 55 comments having positive things to say about the Library, which indicates we are doing many things right. I have listed positive comments with no issues at the end. Even in the comments where students bring up issues, they often also compliment the Library.

The comments are grouped into categories for easier reading. However, I categorized them by the first issue stated in the comment. When there is more than one issue in a comment, I try to reference that comment in all the categories it refers to.

For example: take comment #4 under the Information Desk category, it reads, "4. Access & Website, comment #1" this means that comment number 1 under Access & Website also has a comment related to the Information Desk.

This will give us a better idea of how many comments there were for each category.

The categories are arbitrary and based on what I found most often in the comments. I have copied and pasted the comments here with no editing. In parenthesis after each comment is an abbreviation of the status of the person making the comment.

INFORMATION DESK:

- 1. The information desk needs to manned by professional staff more, not just students. There needs to be staff on all floors to assist with questions, control noise levels, and safety. The innovation studio was a good addition (Library Staff)
- 2. It really makes it hard to get research done here now that they've taken out the help desks on each floor. The employees here are wonderful and helpful, but I have reduced the amount of services I use here (ex: microfilm, clavenovas, etc.) because there are no help desks on that floor. It also makes it very difficult to locate things in the various collections. It really has reduced the quality of my library experience. (Undgr 4th y Gen Stud)
- 3. Bring back the reference librarians to assist students at the Information desk.(Undgr 2nd y NA)
- 4. Access & Website, comment #1

COLLECTIONS:

1. As an international student, I would prefer to have a good quality of translation for the Arabic language. Sometimes, I want to find some sources in Arabic to fully understand the deep meaning of some terminology or sentences in English. (Grad English)

- 2. I wish that you would interact with the Center library more, and not get rid of the government documents section.(Grad Hist/Geo)
- 3. As a Theatre major, I try to read as many plays as I can. Usually I don't know what play I'm looking for. I go to the 3rd floor, and all of the plays are scattered about modern literature. This makes finding plays a struggle. They should have their own section. (Undgr 1st y Theater Arts)
- 4. Need solid works and Matlab on some of the computers (Undgr 4th y Engin/Physics)
- 5. Need more books on Tarot history available in library (Undgr 2nd y Forensics)
- 6. I wish we had more online access for psychology publications. There are some, but they tend to not cover my area of interest. I have been told to talk to the library when there are articles I want or journals that our major could use, and when I have gone to talk to the library about the process no one there seemed to know what to do. (Grad Psychology)
- 7. I find myself missing the resources that I had at OSU. I pretty much only use Google Scholar to find info because many of the sources that I need are not held by our library. (Fac Other)
- 8. Improve databases for research. (Fac Acct)
- 9. Ever since the library started cutting back BIG TIME on printed research journals, I pretty much stopped going there. I can find everything that I need now online, virtually every time. (Fac Math/Stats)
- 10. When the UCO Library stopped carrying many of the print research journals that I used regularly, I stopped going to the Library almost completely. Your faculty and staff are exceptional, but your available resources are (now) severely lacking. (Fac Math/Stats)

SERVICES:

- 1. No coffee (Grad ESFR)
- 2. I've only ever had to use the library a couple times. The resources were fine for what I needed, but as someone who doesn't use the library that often, the library staff treated me like I was absolutely, completely stupid when I need help with something. If that were a non-university job, I'm sure they'd be fired. (Undgr 4th y Theater Arts)
- 3. Please tell more people about the interlibrary loan services for scholarly articles! I learned about it my last semester and wished I had known about it sooner. Thanks! (Undgr 4th y Math/Stats)
- 4. Great study space, awesome resources, sometimes the staff seems a little irritable, but I guess I would be too sitting behind a desk till 2 AM. (Undgr 4th v Marketing)
- 5. Went in the other day to ask if someone could Help me use microfilm and a man at the counter said "well not right now" even though there were multiple workers available. He seemed very unwilling to do his job.(Undgr 2nd y Hist/Geo)
- 6. Provide with free condoms.(Undgr 3rd y Finance)

ACCESS AND WEBSITE:

1. Overall, I do like the library. My only complaints are about the UCO library database, I like it but I hate how sometimes when you find an article it says its available at UCO, and when

you click on it is says it's not available. If it's available at UCO, I would like it to be available online too. My other complaint is how the librarians who can help with research leave after 5 pm. Consider getting someone who can help with research after 5 pm too? (Undgr 4th y Mass Comm)

- 2. The library sources page has been hard to use lately. I get timed out quickly, and cannot make it back to the page I was on. Which is very inconvenience when I am working on a thesis and have been hours deep into research. (Grad Other)
- 3. The website is somewhat confusing and not always reliable. Other than that the library is a great place on campus! (Undgr 1st y Hist/Geo)
- 4. When I have used the main UCO library search engine, I have come across articles that I want to access, listed in the results. But then when I try to access them they are on a database that the library no longer pays for. That can be very frustrating. And I actually use that search bar a lot less to avoid finding an article that I can't use. I tend to stick to databases I know for sure I can access like JSTOR but then I'm probably limiting myself to what I can find in other databases. But even when I tried exploring the alphabetized list of databases, I would come across ones that I needed to pay for. When it comes to research related issues that is the only one that I have encountered. I really like the updates to different studying areas. I do wish there were more individual study rooms. (Grad Hist/Geo)
- 5. 1. The online library database- the OCCC library database allows you to simultaneously search all databases or check all the databases you'd like to search on your initial search. Then, you can narrow it down depending on your results. I feel this is more user friendly and expedient than UCO system where you have to select a particular database first. 2. There are a lot of nice sitting areas for studying, but unfortunately the other students do not always respect that other students are trying to study. One time while I was trying to work in a "Quiet Zone" on the 3rd floor, a girl sat behind me listening to music with her earbuds on and sang to herself out loud the entire time I was there. I have not come to the library to do work since. 3. The open floor plan on the first floor is not especially cozy, and looks a bit overwhelming the first time I entered the library. 4. I love that there is a little store connected to the library so I can get coffee. The seating area with the booths is very nice and convenient for doing work while drinking/eating. Unfortunately the space is often full. The library staff is top notch, very friendly and helpful.
- 6. I have always been quite satisfied with service at the library. People are friendly, capable, and always willing to help. I do not spend much time in the library for study, so the community areas don't really matter to me. It is good, however, to see so many students taking advantage of the space. One thing I find frustrating is when online at the library I sometimes come across links that send me somewhere in expectation of getting the full document, and then the link returns a document not available type of message. Hours:

- 1. I wish the library had longer hours and a cafe! I get off work at 12:30, so the library closing at 2 is an inconvenience and I usually go to Ihop to do my studying because it is open when I need it and it has food and coffee. (Undgr 1st y Forensics)
- 2. The hours of operation are disappointing. I am still a student after 6pm on Friday and Saturday. (Undgr 3rd y Finance)
- 3. As a graduate student that works full-time and is in a doctoral program, it is highly inconvenient that the library is not open past 5 or 6 pm on Friday and Saturday evenings. As a full-time employee my only evenings to work late at the library is the weekend. Additionally, it would be greatly beneficial for there to be a study room with furniture and a printer designated just for Ph.D. students to work on their thesis projects and collaborate with others. (Grad Music)
- 4. If possible, please expand the hours of operation especially on Friday and Saturday nights. 6pm is too early to close. It would be awesome if we could stay and study even just a few more hours.(Undgr 2nd y Crim Jus)
- 5. I wish there were longer hours on the weekend. (Undgr 5th y Hist/Geo)
- 6. I want to extend operation time of library on Friday and Saturday (Undgr 1st y Marketing)

QUIET STUDY & STUDY ROOMS:

- 1. The only issue that I have is that other users of the library can be loud and disruptive in the spaces. It is less of people collaborating, and more horsing around, using loud voices, and making jokes. I hope to see this improved, as it can often be hard to study, especially with students creating distractions.(Undgr 5th y Marketing)
- 2. I would like to see better control over the study rooms. Some people are extremely loud in the rooms with no regards to surrounding rooms being able to hear them. Better-enforced rules of respect and quiet would be appreciated. (Undgr 4th y Nursing)
- 3. Bring back silent zones. need more people on the upper floors for help. Modernize the furniture. (Undgr 2nd y Mass Comm)
- 4. Group study zones should be enforced and groups should be kept from independent study zones more often. Overall, I greatly enjoy the atmosphere. The interior design is a bit dated and I would appreciate it if a renovation of the amazing library was a priority over some of the other buildings. (Undgr 3rd y Psychology)
- 5. Can never find anywhere perfectly quite to study, so I don't come in. (Undgr 3rd y Kinesiology)
- 6. The library is never quiet. I have a terrible time studying or using the group rooms. I've seen people play video games, board games, have birthday parties etc. all in the group rooms. The group rooms are a great place but are ruined by screaming and disrespectful groups who aren't studying. Please fix (Undgr 4th y Marketing)
- 7. Sometimes when people are loud and disruptive, no members of staff ask them to bring the volume down. It would also be nice to have a scanner available--I usually use the one in the education building. Otherwise my experiences here have been wonderful! (Undgr 4th y Teach Ed)

- 9. Great wish there was more space and better known forms to reserve group study rooms.(Undgr 5th y Mass Comm)
- 10. Bring back more red zones because the library is getting too loud. Bring back the desks that used to be on the first floor where students could study individually and not at a table for less distractions. More comfortable chairs. The library is trying to be more modern when it doesn't need to be, keep it how a library should be. It's becoming too loud because there aren't anymore red zones and it's hard to focus. Also since we already have a cafe that's "inside" the library but still outside of the library so it doesn't make noise, is it necessary to have one INSIDE the library? The library is already loud, due to no red zones, the cafe would be louder. It doesn't feel like a library anymore because it's too modern when that's not what we students come to the library for. We come to study and do homework. Bring back the "as you go up the stairs, it gets quieter" system. My biggest complaint is just that there's no quiet/red zones and unnecessary "updates" for the library to make it fancy when libraries don't need to be fancy and modern. The library 3/4 years ago was more comfortable than it is now. (Undgr 4th y Art)
