

APPLICATION FOR DEED.

To Board No. Two, of Townsite Trustees, Assigned by the Honorable Secretary of the Interior to Edmond, Oklahoma Territory:

The undersigned respectfully represents that *he* is the occupant under claim of right of Lot No. *3*..... in Block *24*..... in Edmond, Oklahoma Territory, and believes that *he* is entitled to a deed therefor: That *his* claim is based on the following grounds:

The applicant is over 21 years of age and a citizen of the United States.

applicant is now occupant of said lot and holds same for the purpose of trade and business and has held the same for a period of 12 months and over.

That *he* did not enter upon said Lot.... nor into said Territory in violation of the Act of Congress, approved March 2, 1889, nor of the proclamation of the President of the United States issued thereunder. Therefore *he* asks that said Lot.... may be set off and allotted to *him* and that *he* may receive a deed therefor.

*To this end *I*... hereby appoint *Johnson, Galbreath & Eads*, Attorneys in Fact, with full power and authority, *to act*... and in *my*... name to prosecute *his* claim to a final determination.
