The Journal of the Senate for the March 27, 1950, meeting was approved.

A recommendation concerning "cheating"* was referred to the Committee on University Standards for consideration. (*Made by the Student Conduct Committee in a letter dated April 4, 1950, and addressed to the President.)

Dr. John H. Rohrer discussed the "Regulations Concerning Advanced Standing Examinations" which was approved at the February 28, 1949, meeting of the Senate. The Senate approved Dr. Rohrer's recommendation that the following excerpt from the aforementioned regulations be referred to the Committee on Curriculum for study and recommendation:

". . . such application must be made by a new matriculant in his first semester in residence or by a former student in his first semester of residence after being out of residence one or more semesters. . . ."

Dr. L. H. Snyder reported that "the Graduate Faculty elected Professor C. E. Springer of the Department of Mathematics as representative to the University Senate for a three-year term."

There was no further business, and the Senate adjourned at 4:30 p.m.
