The GLBT community and the Islamic community may at first glance not have much in common. But recent events show us the ignorance, hate and fear not only in the minds of the attackers but also in the minds of those who tell them what to think.

The evening will include remarks from Ms. Siddiqui and a discussion on possible ways to educate and help out each other, not only in times of crisis and disaster - but ways we can all work together everyday of the year.

TOHR membership voted and passed the proposal to improve the by-laws of the organization at the September membership meeting (the meeting was delayed one week due to recent events).

Beginning January 2002, the terms of the Board of Directors will be two years on a rotating basis. The offices of the President, 2nd Vice President and Treasurer will be selected one year while the 1st Vice President and Secretary will be selected the following year. The exception to this will be this coming year when all Executive Committee positions will be elected.

Additionally, the by-law revision created the "Board Development Committee," chaired by a board member,




