Mr. Moody, from the Select Committee on Indian Depredations, submitted the following

REPORT:

[To accompany H. R. 8150.]

The Select Committee on Indian Depredations, to whom was referred H. R. 8150, being "An act to provide for the adjudication and payment of claims arising from Indian depredations," have had the same under consideration, and do now report the same back to the Senate with an amendment by way of a substitute, the substitute being the Senate bill No. 3833, with the same title as the act under consideration, which Senate bill was heretofore by your committee reported to the Senate with the recommendation that it do pass. (Senate Report No. 1016.)

Your committee, upon further consideration, do recommend the pass-

age of the bill, with the proposed amendment as a substitute.
