

LEGISLATIVE, EXECUTIVE, AND JUDICIAL APPROPRIATION BILL.

DECEMBER 14, 1888.—Committed to the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union and ordered to be printed.

Mr. FORNEY, from the Committee on Appropriations, submitted the following

REPORT:

[To accompany bill H. R. 11795.]

In presenting the bill making appropriations for legislative, executive, and judicial expenses of the Government for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1890, the Committee on Appropriations submit the following in explanation thereof:

The estimates on which the bill is based are to be found on pages 9 to 66 and 72 to 78 of the Book of Estimates for 1890, and aggregate in all \$21,087,485.25, of which amount there is recommended in the bill \$20,802,245.81.

The appropriations for the same purposes for the current fiscal year aggregate \$20,940,440.57, being \$138,194.76 more than is recommended in the accompanying bill for the service of the fiscal year 1890.

The amount appropriated by the bill is \$285,240.44 less than the aggregate estimates submitted.

The whole number of salaries specifically provided for in the bill is 9,920, being 94 less than the number estimated for and 20 less than the number provided for in the current law.

The bill contains no new legislation.

Changes in the number or grade of officers or employés of the Government, and their rate of compensation, as compared with the current law, are recommended in the bill as follows:

SENATE.

The bill provides for the officers, clerks, messengers, and others in the service of the Senate in the same terms as is contained in the current law, except where it is necessary to provide for the difference between the approaching long session and the short session of Congress, making an apparent increase of \$32,208.30 over the appropriation for this service for 1889.

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

Under a resolution of the House, adopted August 23, 1888, provision is made for a clerk to the Committee on Merchant-Marine and Fisheries, at an annual salary of \$2,000 from March 3 next.

2 LEGISLATIVE, EXECUTIVE, AND JUDICIAL APPROPRIATIONS.

The number of session committee clerks is reduced from 39 to 36, and the provision for the pay of the clerk to the Committee on the Census up to March 3 next, at the rate of \$2,000 per annum, contained in the current law, is omitted from the bill. Otherwise the bill provides for the officers, clerks, and other employes in the service of the House in the same terms as is contained in the current law, except where it is necessary to provide for the difference between the approaching long session and the short session of Congress, making an apparent net increase of \$32,331.16 over the appropriation for the fiscal year 1889.

EXECUTIVE.

The salary of the Vice-President is provided for for the entire fiscal year 1890; for the current fiscal year provision is made for this salary only from March 4, 1889.

TREASURY DEPARTMENT.

A reduction is made of one clerk at \$1,600, in the office of the Supervising Architect.

WAR DEPARTMENT.

One clerk or stenographer, at \$1,600, for the General of the Army in the office of the Secretary of War is omitted. Two clerks, at \$1,200 each, and 7 clerks, at \$1,200 each, are transferred from the Secretary's office to the office of the Adjutant-General.

SIGNAL SERVICE.

The force in this office is re arranged, as requested by the Chief Signal Officer, being reduced five in number, and \$1,200 in the aggregate of their compensation.

REBELLION RECORDS OFFICE.

A reduction is made of one copy-holder, at \$900.

INTERIOR DEPARTMENT.

A reduction is made in the Secretary's office, as follows:

Three members of the board of pension appeals, at \$2,000 each.

One special inspector of the public-land service, at \$2,500.

Three law clerks, at \$2,000 each (in the Assistant Attorney-General's office).
