RESOLUTION:

*Resolved*, That for reasons set forth in the report of the Committee on Indian Affairs upon the President's message of February eighteenth, eighteen hundred and ninety-two, upon the appropriation of March third, eighteen hundred and ninety-one, for payment to Choctaw and Chickasaw Nation for their interest in the Cheyenne and Arapaho Reservation, in the Indian Territory, submitted with this resolution, that it is the opinion of the Senate that there is no sufficient reason for interference in the due execution of the law referred to.
