RESOLUTION:

Resolved, That the Secretary of the Interior be, and is hereby, instructed to furnish to the Senate, at the earliest possible moment, copies of all contracts made by the United States with citizens, for furnishing beef cattle to the Indians of the southern and northern superintendencies during the years 1883 and 1884, with names and residences of all those to whom said contracts were let, together with all correspondence and instructions from the Commissioner of Indian Affairs in any way appertaining or relating to said contracts.
