OFFICE OF CHEROKEE COMMISSION,  
*Washington July 23, 1847.*

SIR: The undersigned commissioners, appointed under the 17th article of the treaty concluded at New Echota, in the State of Georgia, on the 29th day of December, in the year 1835, by General William Carroll and John F. Schermerhorn, commissioners on the part of the United States, and the chiefs, head-men, and people of the Cherokee tribe of Indians, would respectfully beg leave to report:

On the 23d day of July, 1846, the board was commissioned; having been limited, by act of Congress, to one year from that date. Before that year expires, and as they are about to conclude their labors, they think it their duty to furnish a brief statement of the business transacted by them. The board organized on the 31st day of July, 1846; and from that time to the present, it has been constantly in session, and kept open for the convenience of claimants, for the purpose of filing cases and examining the papers and records in the office of the commission; and, at the same time, the commissioners have been engaged in the investigation of the claims presented, and in rendering their decrees thereon. The number of claims filed, the amount demanded, and the sums allowed and rejected, are all contained in a tabular statement hereto appended, to which they respectfully beg leave to refer.

Soon after the organization of the commission, the following

rules were adopted, and published in the "Union" newspaper, in this city, under date of the 29th August, 1846.

"*Cherokee commission.*—The commissioners to examine claims under the treaty with the Cherokees, of 1835-'6, will meet, for the duties of their appointment, in one of the rooms in the basement of the capitol, where all claims will be presented. The commissioners have established the following regulations:

"I. All proofs relating to claims shall be in writing, legally authenticated; and the evidence of witnesses shall be in writing, under oath legally administered and authenticated, and deposited with the secretary of the commission.

"II. All arguments, statements, applications, or motions of counsel, attorneys, agents, or claimants, shall be in writing, and deposited with the secretary of the commission.

"III. All the papers filed with the commission, shall be deposited with the secretary, and cannot be withdrawn by any person, under any pretext whatever.

"IV. The commissioners will not permit any claimant, or any person concerned for them, to converse with the commissioners or their secretary, *privately*, upon the subject of any claim, or any matter relating thereto."

As will be seen by these rules, it was considered to be prudent to require all arguments to be in writing, and deposited with the secretary of the commission, so that the records might show the reasons assigned in support of each claim, and contribute to explain the points as determined by the commissioners, and thus be a perpetual memorial of each transaction, by which all misrepresentation could be prevented for the future.

With the papers received from the Indian Office, there were a great number of claims which had been brought from the west by the former board of commissioners, and which it was necessary to have decided. Knowing that many of these claimants resided in North Carolina and west of the Mississippi, the following order was made, and published for four successive weeks, in the Washington "Union," "Highland Messenger," Ashville, North Carolina, and "Cherokee Advocate," Talequah, Cherokee nation. The date of the order is the 24th September, 1846.

"*Cherokee commission.*—Inasmuch as the greater proportion of cases left unacted upon by the last board of commissioners are in a very imperfect condition, owing to the neglect of claimants, and cannot be investigated by the commissioners for want of statements, arguments, and proof; and as it is the intention of the commissioners to dispose of the cases submitted to them, promptly, and put an end to these protracted investigations, the following additional order is made:

"All claimants must file their memorials or applications in writing, together with a complete preparation of their cases for final action, with the secretary of the board, on or before the 25th day of December, 1846; and no memorials or applications will be received after that day, unless good cause be shown for the delay, verified by affidavit."

Notwithstanding the publication of this order, on the 25th day of December very few of the cases were ready or properly prepared for examination; when, upon that day, a supplemental order was issued, in the following terms:

*“Ordered, That the period fixed by the order of the board of the 24th of September last, be, and the same is hereby, extended until the 1st day of January, 1847; and that claimants have until that day to file their respective claims.”*

In the meanwhile the commissioners progressed in deciding those cases which were prepared and presented to them. And on the 31st day of December, 1846, the board concluded that properly they could not delay their action upon any cases on file in their office; thereupon they gave directions to their secretary, as follows:

*“Ordered, That the secretary receive and place on file all claims that may be presented for the action of the board until otherwise directed.”*

On the 9th of February, 1847, an order was made, the purpose of which was to give notice to all attorneys and persons prosecuting claims before the board, that they must have their cases in a state of preparation, and not delay the commission by applications for continuances, many of which were then on file. This order was reduced to writing and recorded upon the minutes, as were those which have been before quoted, and is in the following words:

*“Ordered, That the secretary give notice to claimants and their attorneys, that it is necessary and will be required by the board, that they should have their cases immediately prepared for examination by the commissioners; and that hereafter, when a case is filed, it must be prepared for the action of the board, and will be so considered from the date of filing the same.”*

This order was notified to all those concerned, by posting the same up in the office of the commissioner—where it has remained to this date.”

In nearly every instance, the claims were represented by attorneys, or were among the papers which had been deposited with the preceding commission, and sent to us from the Indian office for our action.

At one time the commissioners were induced to believe that the business would be so increased by new claims that it would be impossible to complete their duties within the time allotted; but it was subsequently ascertained that by constant exertion any further time would be unnecessary.

It will thus be seen that the commission has given the most public notice to the claimants, that all might prepare and present their demands. The notice of the 24th of September gave information not only of the condition of the cases then with the commissioners, but it was also a sufficient warning to all claimants that they must be prompt and diligent in the preparation and prosecution of their cases. Care was taken to send that order

abroad, by publications made in the newspapers printed in the regions of country where the claimants resided.

The claimants were not taken by surprise; nor were their cases ever acted on without giving time for preparation. After all proper delay, the claims brought from the west by the former commissioners, were taken up and examined, several times, with care. The commissioners have succeeded in disposing of every one of these claims, and they now complete their official term after having examined and determined upon every case before them, and without a single demand unadjusted and undecided.

It is due to Mr. Miller, the secretary of the commission, to state that, by his industry and skill, the commissioners have been enabled to finish their task; and that his complete and methodical record will not only bear witness to their joint labors, but will also be a perpetual record of all things done by this commission.
