RESOLUTION:

Resolved, That for reasons set forth in the report of the Committee on Indian Affairs upon the President's message of February 17, 1892, upon the appropriation of March 3, 1891, for payment to the Choctaw and Chickasaw nations for their interest in the Cheyenne and Arapahoe Reservation, submitted with this resolution, it is the opinion of the House of Representatives that there is no sufficient reason for interference in the due execution of the law referred to.
