## REPORT:

[To accompany bill H. R. 9736.]

The Committee on the Public Lands, to whom was referred the bill (H. R. 8543) granting to the Maricopa and Phænix Railway Company, of Arizona, the right of way through the Gila River Indian Reservation, having had the same under consideration, respectfully report:

That they have submitted the bill to the Interior Department; and the Commissioner of Indian Affairs suggests certain amendments, which your committee have adopted, and believing all rights amply guarded, they report a substitute for said bill containing said amendments, and recommend its passage.
