Mr. HENDRICKS, from the Committee on Invalid Pensions, made the following

REPORT.

*The Committee on Invalid Pensions, to whom was referred the petition of Joel Collins, of Ohio, asking pension for services in the Indian wars prior to 1800, report :*

That there is abundant proof of valuable services rendered by said Collins in said wars; that he has attained the advanced age of 81 years, is poor, and not able to support himself.

Your committee, therefore, report a bill granting him a pension of six dollars a month, and recommend its passage.
