REPORT.

The Committee on Indian Affairs, to whom was referred the petition of Dimick B. Huntington, for services connected with the Indians in Utah Territory, report:

That they have examined the same, and do not perceive any legal or moral obligation devolved on the government to make the donation the petitioner claims. His humanity to the poor Indian is praiseworthy, but does not fix an obligation on the government to reimburse charities he voluntarily dispenses. Your committee ask to be discharged from the monsideration of the petition, recommending that the prayer thereof be not granted.
