REPORT.

The Committee on Military Affairs, to whom was referred the memorial of N. G. Evans, of the 2d dragoons, United States army, respectfully report:

The memorialist claims compensation for his personal baggage sent to him by the quartermaster at Fort Leavenworth in the train of the 30th of September, 1850, belonging to Brown, Russell & Co., which was destroyed by fire being set to the same by the Indians whilst it was en route to New Mexico. Without reference to the principle involved in the case, the committee find no evidence of a sufficient character as to the value of the baggage of the memorialist. They accordingly ask to be discharged from the further consideration of the memorial.
