# LEGISLATIVE, EXECUTIVE, AND JUDICIAL APPROPRIATION BILL. 

May 10, 1880.-Read twice, recommitted to the Committee on Appropriations and ordered to be printed.

Mr. Atrins, from the Committee on Appropriations, submitted the following

## REPORT:

[To accompany bill H. R. 6185.]
In resenting to the House the bill making provisions for the legislative, seoutive, and judicial expenses of the government for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1881, the Committee on Appropriations herewith submit the following report:

The estimates upon which the bill is based are to be found on pages 9 to 66, both inclusive, of the book of estimates, except pages 60,61 , - 62, which contain the estimates of appropriations asked for by the artment of Agriculture, the consideration of which the Committee Agriculture is now charged with under the rules of the House.
The total expenses for the legislative, executive, and judicial branches of the government estimated for in the book of estimates, added to the oupplemental estimates sent in by the various heads of departments during the session, aggregate in all $\$ 16,691,920.59$; of which sum the committee, after thorough and exhaustive consideration of the requirements of the service, recommend in this bill $\$ 16,120,931.91$. The apopriations for similar purposes for the current year amounted to \%,527,938.58, or $\$ 592,993.33$ less than is recommended by the comthee for the ensuing fiscal year.
The following statement will explain more fully and in detail the bill, and make a comparison of the items composing it, with the appropritions of same character for the present year, and the estimates upon which it is mainly based.
