RESOLUTION:

Resolved, That the Secretary of the Interior be, and he is hereby, requested to furnish this House the following information, if not incompatible with the public interests, viz:

(1) What school facilities have been furnished to the Sioux Nation of Indians of Dakota, in accordance with the provisions of the treaty made

with said Indians, under date of April 29, 1868.

(2) What recommendations as to the proper policy to be pursued to carry out that clause of the treaty aforesaid, providing for educational facilities among said tribe of Indians, as will, in the opinion of the Department, best conduce to their civilization.
