REPORT:

[To accompany bill S. 2992.]

The Committee on Indian Affairs, to whom was referred Senate bill 2992, to accept and ratify the agreement submitted by the Shoshone, Bannock, and Sheepeater tribes of Indians of Fort Hall and Lemhi Reservations, in Idaho, May 14, 1880, and for other purposes, have considered the same and recommend its passage.
