We find that said claimant lost the property described by Indian depredations in the Indian war of 1855-756 in Oregon and Washington Territories by various bands of Indians, and that said property was of the value of \$1,558; that said B. B. Bishop is a man of credibility, and his statements can be relied on, and we therefore recommend the payment of the said sum of \$1,558.
