REPORT:

[To accompany bill H. R. 5271.]

The Select Committee on Indian Depredation Claims, to whom was referred the bill (H. R. 5271) for the relief of Joseph Russell, submit the following report:

We find that Joseph Russell was the owner of certain property in Douglas County, Oregon, which was taken and destroyed by the Cow Creek and Umpqua Indians in the hostilities of 1855-56, and that said property was of the value of \$310.

We recommend payment thereof.
